AN ORDINANCE

declaring the results of the Special Election held in the City of Columbia, Missouri on November 5, 2013; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That it is hereby found and declared that the vote at the special election held in the City of Columbia, Missouri, on Tuesday, November 5, 2013, on the following question:

PROPOSITION 1

Shall the City of Columbia, Missouri issue its Sewer System Revenue Bonds in the amount of Thirty-two Million Three Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$32,340,000.00) for the purpose of constructing, improving, repairing, rehabilitating, replacing, equipping, expanding, and extending the City-owned sewerage system?

That attached hereto as Exhibit A is a full, true and correct copy of the certification of votes cast at said election received from the County Clerk of Boone County, Missouri, that said certification of votes is the final and last certification of votes for said election, and that said certification of votes constitutes the official returns of the election pursuant to Section 115.507(2) of the Comprehensive Election Act, Revised Statutes of Missouri, as amended.

SECTION 4. That it is further found and declared that notice of said election was duly given by publication in the manner provided by law as evidenced by the affidavits of publication attached hereto as Exhibit B, and that said election was held and conducted in all respects in conformity with the Constitution and laws of the State of Missouri.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
