A RESOLUTION

authorizing staff to proceed with the preliminary design and expenditure of funds associated with the proposed construction of the Shannon Place Private Common Collector Elimination Project (PCCE #22); directing that a public hearing be held upon completion of the preliminary plans.

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2009, the City Clerk received a petition for the formation of a private common collector elimination (PCCE) project from certain property owners in the vicinity of Shannon Place; and

WHEREAS, City's Public Works Department identified the private common collector sewer that serves the Shannon Place area to be in poor structural condition; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that the proposed Shannon Place Private Common Collector Elimination Project (PCCE #22) would involve construction of approximately 230 feet of new public sewer at a preliminary estimated cost of \$80,000.00.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes and directs staff to proceed with the preliminary design and expenditure of funds associated with the proposed construction of the Shannon Place Private Common Collector Elimination Project (PCCE #22).

SECTION 2. Upon completion of the preliminary plans for the proposed Shannon Place Private Common Collector Elimination Project (PCCE #22), the City Council further directs that a public hearing be held in respect to this improvement.

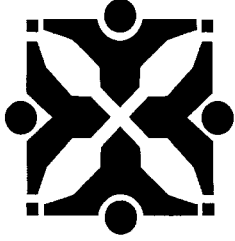

Re: Proposed Private Common Collector Elimination Project (PCCE #22) on Shannon Place

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Staff has prepared for Council consideration legislation authorizing staff to proceed with the preliminary design to determine the feasibility and costs associated with the proposed private common collector elimination project on Shannon Place. Attached is a copy of the petition signed by property owners of two separate parcels on Shannon Place, and a map showing the proposed private common collector study area.

DISCUSSION:

There are four parcels in the study area of Shannon Place that require public gravity sewer. These parcels are currently connected to a private common collector sewer that is in poor structural condition and needs to be replaced. A petition signed by property owners of two of the four parcels is attached. The project would involve constructing approximately 230 feet of new public sewer with a preliminary estimated cost of \$80,000.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The project is estimated to cost \$80,000 and will be funded from the Sewer Utility Private Common Collector Elimination budget.

VISION IMPACT:

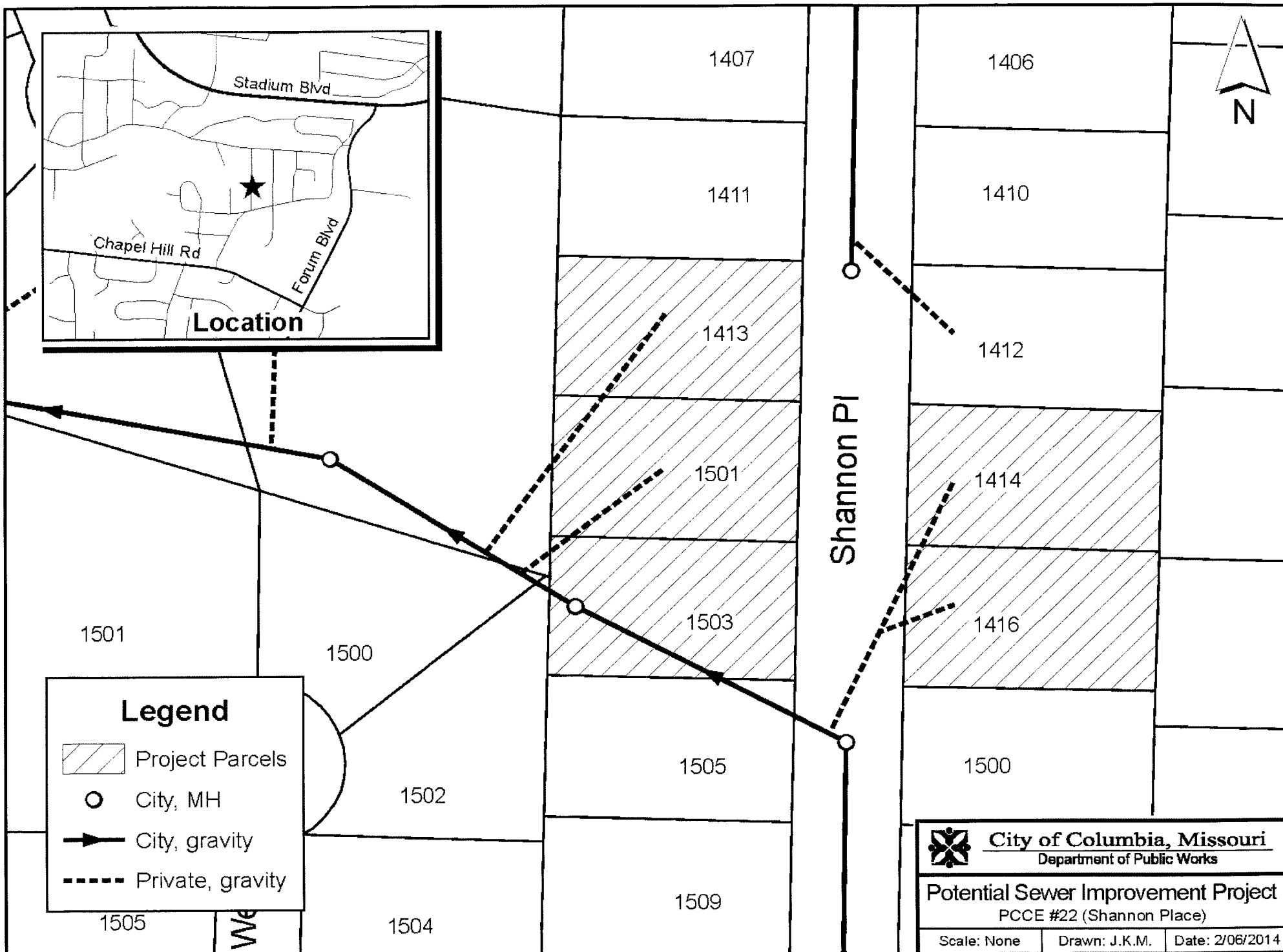
