Members of the public were present.

Dr. Martin called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

The draft meeting minutes of the January 8, 2014 regular meeting were distributed in advance of the meeting and were approved.

Mr. Sheltmire said that the Columbia Police Department was in contact with him about new recruit training. Mr. Sheltmire and Mr. Dowis will attend the training to speak about the Board on Friday, February 14, 2014.

Mr. Sheltmire has been contacting Neighborhood Associations to set up appointments to attend their neighborhood association meetings to speak about the Board.

Mr. Fisher is appointed as a member of the Outreach Subcommittee.

Mr. Dean has been placing CPRB brochures at various places in the downtown area.

Rose Wibbenmeyer provided an update on the RFP for the mediation project.

The Board discussed the response they received from Chief Burton regarding their proposed ordinance changes. Mr. Sheltmire made a motion to extend an invitation to the Chief to provide the Board with optional dates to have a discussion regarding proposed ordinance changes. Ms. Wilson seconded the motion and it was passed unanimously.

The Board discussed proposed changes to the CPRB bylaws. Dr. Alexander made a motion that the Board members look through the latest proposed revisions of the bylaws

that were distributed, make comments, and come back with them to the next meeting. Dr. Kennett seconded that motion and it was passed unanimously.

Dr. Alexander made a motion that the Citizens Police Review Board 2013 Annual Report be approved. Ms. Wilson seconded the motion and it was passed unanimously.

The Board discussed supplemental budget requests for fiscal year 2015 and the possibility of requesting the supplemental funds for fiscal year 2014 to attend the NACOLE conference in Kansas City if necessary.

Sergeant Chad Craig gave a presentation on recruiting and training of police officers.

Dr. Alexander discussed recent contact from an affiliate of the Columbia Vision Commission and her request for information from the Board.

The Board discussed the possibility of holding a regional conference for boards from other areas to gather together and exchange ideas.

Rose Wibbenmeyer announced that there is a training session for new volunteer advocates on February 26, 2014.

No member of the public commented.

The Board unanimously agreed to adjourn the meeting at 8:53 p.m.
