Executive Summary

This ordinance would provide flexibility by allowing a change in the membership structure of the Board of Plumbing Examiners. It currently requires the Council to appoint one master plumber, one journeyman plumber and two laypersons. The journeyman plumber has been difficult to fill and journeyman plumbers sometimes move to a master plumber position. This will allow the journeyman position to be filled by either a journeyman plumber or a master plumber.

Discussion

The Board of Plumbing Examiners currently consists of "five members, one of whom shall be the director of community development or the director's designee, who shall be a non-voting, ex-officio secretary of the board; a second member, who shall be a master plumber; a third member, who shall be a journeyman plumber; and a fourth member and a fifth member, who shall be persons not engaged in, working at, employed by, or connected with plumbing, a plumbing firm, contractor, or the plumbing industry."

The person that was appointed to the journeyman plumber position in 2007 continued his professional development and became a master plumber, and the Council, at the request of the Board of Plumbing Examiners, chose to continue to allow him to serve as the journeyman plumber position since the master plumber position was already filled.

This ordinance change would make it clear the position could be held by either a journeyman plumber or a master plumber.

AN ORDINANCE

amending Chapter 6 of the City Code to change the membership requirement for the Board of Plumbing Examiners; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 6 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 6-52. Amendments.

The code adopted by this article is hereby amended by substituting the following sections in lieu of those sections with corresponding numbers in the code, or, where there is no corresponding section in the code, the following sections shall be enacted as additions to the code:

. . .

101.6 Board of plumbing examiners: There is hereby created a board of plumbing examiners, consisting of five (5) members, one of whom shall be the director of community development or the director's designee, who shall be a non-voting, ex-officio secretary of the board; a second member, who shall be a master plumber; a third member, who shall be a master plumber or journeyman plumber; and a fourth member and a fifth member, who shall be persons not engaged in, working at, employed by, or connected with plumbing, a plumbing firm, contractor, or the plumbing industry. Members appointed by the council shall be residents of the City of Columbia. Members shall be appointed by the council at the second regular meeting of the council in May, biennially in odd-numbered years, for a term of two (2) years, beginning on the first day of June and serving until their successors are appointed and qualified. The second and third members of the board shall have at least six (6) years in, or working at, the plumbing business at the time of their appointment. The first meeting of the calendar year, the board shall select one of its members to serve as chair and the code official shall designate a clerk from the
