Executive Summary

Authorizing a bid call through the Purchasing Division for the construction of the Keene Street Pavement Improvement project from I-70 Drive SE to East Broadway (see attached location diagram). Council approved the Surface Transportation Program (STP) Agreement with the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission for this project on November 4, 2013. An Interested Parties (IP) meeting was held March 25, 2014, and a public hearing was held on June 2, 2014.

Discussion

At the June 2, 2014 public hearing, Council directed staff to proceed with plans and specifications for the Keene Street Pavement Improvement project. The proposed project includes resurfacing Keene Street from I-70 Drive SE to East Broadway (Route WW). The resurfacing includes milling the existing concrete pavement surface to a depth of approximately 1-1/2 inches, and placing a thin lift asphalt overlay. Except for certain areas where pavement distresses extend to the curb, and at intersections, the milling and overlay will extend from bicycle lane to bicycle lane. Thus, the resulting roadway will have asphalt pavement for the vehicle lanes and concrete for the bike lanes. Staff feels the contrasting bike lanes will provide a benefit to cyclists, while also saving money. Preliminary plans are attached.

In order to satisfy requirements of Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), curb ramps along this route will be brought into compliance with current ADA requirements. Many of the existing curb ramps predate current ADA requirements and are not accessible; therefore, 19 curb ramps will be altered or reconstructed as part of this project. No additional easements will be needed for the project, and it's anticipated that the resurfacing work will be completed during night-time hours to limit disruption.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The estimated cost of this project is \$287,000, which was appropriated when the STP-Urban Program agreement was authorized with MHTC. The state will reimburse the City 80%, or \$229,600, and the City's local match of \$57,400 will be paid from Street Operations Maintenance account.

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Long-Term Impact: The mill and overlay will prolong the life of the street, extending the timeframe for extensive reconstruction by 10+ years.

AN ORDINANCE

determining it is in the public interest to construct pavement improvements on Keene Street, from I-70 Drive SE to East Broadway (Route WW); approving and adopting plans and specifications; determining that the work shall be done by contract; calling for bids through the Purchasing Division; providing for payment for the improvement; authorizing the City Manager to obtain, execute and record all documents necessary for the improvement; providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law and state-mandated construction safety training; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted a resolution declaring the necessity of constructing pavement improvements on Keene Street, from I-70 Drive SE to East Broadway (Route WW); and

WHEREAS, the notice of a public hearing on this project was published in a daily newspaper of general circulation in the city; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has held a public hearing on construction of the improvement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Council finds that the construction of pavement improvements on Keene Street, from I-70 Drive SE to East Broadway (Route WW), and other miscellaneous work, all in accordance with City of Columbia Street and Storm Sewer Specifications and Standards, in the City of Columbia, Missouri, is necessary for the welfare and improvement of the city and that it is in the public interest that such improvements be made. Specific improvements include milling the existing concrete pavement surface, from bicycle lane to bicycle lane, to a depth of approximately 1½-inches and placing a thin lift asphalt overlay, and the reconstruction of curb ramps to be ADA compliant.

SECTION 2. The plans and specifications for this improvement, as prepared by the Director of Public Works, are hereby approved and made a part of this ordinance by reference.

SECTION 3. The construction of the improvement shall be done by contract in accordance with the plans and specifications, the laws of the State of Missouri, and the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri.

SECTION 4. The Purchasing Agent is hereby authorized to call for bids and execute a contract for the improvement.

SECTION 5. Payment for this improvement shall be made from Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission STP funding, annual street maintenance funds and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated. Per the terms of an STP-Urban Program agreement, the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission shall reimburse the City 80%, or \$229,600.00, of the project costs, and the City's local match is \$57,400.00.

SECTION 6. The City Manager is authorized to obtain, execute and have recorded all licenses, easements, deeds and any other conveyances or instruments necessary for the City to complete this improvement.

SECTION 7. The contract for the improvement shall provide that not less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages, as found by the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations of Missouri, shall be paid to all workers performing work under the contract. The contractor's bond shall guarantee the faithful performance of the prevailing hourly wage clause in the contract.

SECTION 8. The bid specifications and contract for the improvement shall provide that the contractor and any subcontractor shall provide a ten-hour Occupational Safety and Health Administration construction safety program (or a similar program approved by the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations) for all employees working on-site. All employees working on the site of the improvement are required to complete the safety program within 60 days of beginning work on the improvement project.






KEENE STREET PAVEMENT IMPROVEMENTS

OVERALL PLAN


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
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
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
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


KEENE STREET PAVEMENT IMPROVEMENTS Skidewalk Curb Ramp Plan Sheet City of Columbia, Missouri


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



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
