Executive Summary

Amending Chapter 14 of the City Code of Ordinances to establish reserved parking for police vehicles on a portion of Richmond Avenue.

Discussion

For safety and security purposes, reserved parking was established on the west side Richmond Avenue, just north of Burnam Road, for police vehicle parking only. Although this has been in place for several years, Section 14-335 of the City Code had not been amended to include this location as reserved police parking. Staff has verified that the curb on the west side of Richmond Avenue is painted yellow from the north curb of Burnam Avenue to a point of sixty feet north. Additionally, there is an existing sign at this location indicating "Reserved Parking, Police Vehicles, Here To Corner".

AN ORDINANCE

amending Chapter 14 of the City Code to provide reserved parking for police vehicles along a portion of the west side of Richmond Avenue; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 14 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 14-335. Reserved parking for police vehicles.

(a) When signs are placed, erected or installed giving notice thereof, it shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle other than a Columbia Police Department vehicle at any time on the east side of Sixth Street, from the south curbline of Walnut Street to a point sixty-five (65) feet south thereof. The police department shall pay the parking utility a fee of five hundred twenty dollars (\$520.00) per year (or monthly proration thereof) for this space.

. . .

- (g) When signs are placed, erected or installed giving notice thereof, it shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle other than a Columbia Police Department vehicle at any time on the north side of Parkade Boulevard from a point one hundred sixty-five (165) feet east of Bear Creek Drive to a point one hundred ninety (190) feet east of Bear Creek Drive.
- (h) When signs are placed, erected or installed giving notice thereof, it shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle other than a Columbia Police Department vehicle at any time on the west side of Richmond Avenue from the north curbline of Burnam Avenue to a point sixty (60) feet north thereof.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
