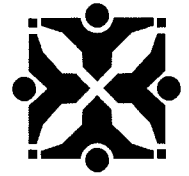

Executive Summary

On December 30, 2014, the city clerk certified the petition to recall Council Member Chadwick contained a sufficient number of valid signatures of registered voters in the First Ward (certification attached) for a recall under the City Charter.

Discussion

Pamela Cooper filed a petition with the city clerk on December 8, 2014, demanding the recall of First Ward Council Member Chadwick. Following an extensive review of the signatures presented, the city clerk certified the recall petition had been signed by a sufficient number of registered voters within the First Ward (see attached certification dated December 30, 2014) to qualify for submission to the voters. Pursuant to Section 137 of the City Charter, the election on such recall is to be held at the next available municipal election which is consistent with applicable notice provisions set forth in state law. The final certification date for ballot issues to be provided to the county clerk for the April 7, 2015 municipal election day is January 27, 2015. Accordingly, an ordinance has been prepared to call for a special election to be held in the First Ward of the City of Columbia, Missouri on April 7, 2015 to consider the recall of Council Member Chadwick.

Section 139 of the City Charter provides that in the event a majority of persons who vote in the recall election vote in favor of the recall, a vacancy in the office shall exist and the vacancy shall be filled as provided in Section 9 of the Charter. Section 9 would require a special election to fill the vacancy. In such event, the council would order the special election by resolution at its April 20, 2015 meeting and at such time, the timeframe for submission of nominating petitions to fill the vacancy would be established to meet filing deadlines for the August 4, 2015 election date.

In the alternative, if a majority of persons vote against the recall, the council member remains in office and no further action will be taken.



AN ORDINANCE

calling a special election in the First Ward of the City of Columbia, Missouri, to be held on Tuesday, April 7, 2015, to consider the recall of Council member Ginny Chadwick; describing the form of the notice of election; authorizing and directing the City Clerk to give notice of the election; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A special election is hereby ordered to be held in the First Ward in the City of Columbia, Missouri, on Tuesday, April 7, 2015, on the following question:

SECTION 2. The form of the Notice of Special Election shall be substantially as set forth in "Exhibit A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to notify the Clerk of the County Commission of Boone County, Missouri, of the passage of this ordinance no later than 5:00 o'clock p.m. on January 27, 2015, and to include in the notification all of the terms and provisions required by Chapter 115, RSMo. as amended.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.











PETITION TO RECALL FIRST WARD COUNCIL MEMBER VIRGINIA "GINNY" CHADWICK

First Ward Council member Ginny Chadwick has betrayed the trust of her constituents in many ways, including the following:



CERTIFICATION RE: PETITION TO RECALL FIRST WARD COUNCIL MEMBER VIRGINIA "GINNY" CHADWICK

Per Sections 136 and 137 of the Charter of the City of Columbia, Missouri, I, Sheela Amin, City Clerk in and for the City of Columbia, County of Boone, State of Missouri, hereby certify today, December 30, 2014, that the recall petition entitled *Petition to Recall First Ward Council Member Virginia "Ginny" Chadwick* has been signed by a sufficient number of registered voters as it has been signed by 319 City of Columbia registered voters.

The required number of First Ward - City of Columbia registered voter signatures needed was equal in number to at least 30 percent of the number of votes cast at the last municipal election for first ward council member, which by my calculation comes to 249 signatures (827 x 30%).
