Executive Summary

The Parks and Recreation Department is requesting Council approval to proceed with improvements to the park property located at 3405 Zinnia Drive and adopt "Barberry Park" as the official name of the park. As identified in the FY-2015 Capital Improvement Program, staff is proposing improvements at the 5.28-acre park, including the addition of a small shelter, playground, walking trail, open play field and basketball court. The total budget for the park development is \$125,000, with funding coming from the 2010 Park Sales Tax. The project will be bid through the City's Purchasing Department and will be completed using a combination of contract and force account labor. Improvements at the park are scheduled to begin spring 2015 with an anticipated completion date of late fall 2015.

Discussion

The 5.28-acre Barberry Park, located at 3405 Zinnia Drive, was purchased by the Parks and Recreation Department in 2009 with the intent to construct a neighborhood park on the property. The two lots purchased by the Department are part of the Valley View Ridge Subdivision located in northwest Columbia. The need to develop a neighborhood park in this area of Columbia was identified in the 2002 Parks, Recreation and Open Space Master Plan. As a new park property, the Parks and Recreation Department is requesting Council approval to give the Department permission to proceed with the park development and establish "Barberry Park" as the official name of the park.

In September 2014, park planning staff began the process of identifying possible amenities to be located within the neighborhood park property. Discussion focused on utilizing the existing pond on the property and the park's proximity to surrounding neighborhoods and other parks and amenities in this area of Columbia. After park staff prepared a proposed plan for improvements, an interested parties meeting was held on October 7, 2014 at the Activity and Recreation Center to gather feedback regarding the potential improvements. Four individuals spoke with park staff, and two individuals filled out comment forms regarding the improvements to the park. Park staff also introduced the proposed improvements to the Parks & Recreation Commission at their January 15, 2015 meeting. After discussion of the project, the Commissioners approved the plans for the park development without discussion. After considering all citizen comments and the P&R Commission recommendation, staff believes that proposed improvements at Barberry Park represent a consensus of park users, P&R Commission and staff.

The proposed improvements at Barberry Park will include many typical neighborhood park amenities, including a 24' diameter shelter, playground for ages 5-12 and a half-court basketball court. Contract labor will be used for the installation of the playground, and park staff will construct the small shelter and basketball court. The park property has an existing pond located in the northeast corner of the park. Contract labor will be used to reconstruct the existing pond to create a ¾-acre pond. The enlarged pond will serve as a fishing amenity, as well as for storm water control. The excess soil from the pond construction will be used to construct an open play field within the park on the east side of the property. Following the completion of the pond and open play field improvements, contract labor will be used to pour a six-foot concrete trail around the pond and connecting walkways to provide citizens with access to the park from Zinnia Drive and Grayson Drive. Lastly, park staff will complete all necessary landscaping improvements to the park, including tree planting, turf establishment and the addition of edible landscape plantings. Park staff will plant fruit or nut producing trees and fruit producing shrubs in designated areas of the park. A complete signage plan for the park will also be added to educate the public about the availability and location of edible plants at the park. A plan showing the proposed improvements to the park property is included with this Council memo.

The park improvements at Barberry Park are included in the City's FY-2015 Capital Improvement Program budget, with site construction scheduled to begin this spring 2015. Staff anticipates that the improvements will be completed by late fall 2015. All work and materials will be bid through the City's Purchasing Department and will be completed using a combination of contract and force account labor.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The total project cost for park improvements is \$125,000 and is funded by the 2010 Park Sales Tax.

Long-Term Impact: Barberry Park will require annual maintenance of all grounds and amenities. The annual budget impact to operations once the park is fully developed would be approximately \$2,000 to \$3,000 based on the maintenance associated with the shelter, playground, mowing of the park and trash service. Staff has been mowing the park property since the acquisition of the property in 2009.
