Executive Summary

Authorizing an agreement with North Village Arts District Farmers and Artisans Market for the use of the Wabash Station parking lot on Sundays, beginning in April through October, for the Columbia downtown farmers' market.

Discussion

In April of 2014, Council authorized an agreement between the City and the North Village Arts District Farmers and Artisans Market to use the Wabash Station parking lot on Sundays, between the months of April and October, for operation of a downtown farmers' market.

They have once again submitted a proposal and agreement to use the Wabash Station parking lot on Sundays, beginning April 11, 2015 through October 12, 2015, from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM, to provide community access to fresh nutritious produce, quality goods and unique crafts. They will work closely with the Health Department to ensure all food products are safe and all conditions are sanitary, and will be responsible for trash removal and cleaning of the parking lot.

Attached is a letter of support from the director of the downtown Community Improvement District, as well as support from local businesses in the area.

WHEREAS, the City owns and operates the Wabash Station, property located at 126 North Tenth Street, Columbia, Missouri 65201; and

WHEREAS, NVAD desires to use the Wabash Station parking lot on Sundays beginning April 11, 2015 through October 12, 2015, for a downtown farmers market.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants set out herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. NVAD, applying as a non-profit organization, will be granted permission to use the parking lot located directly behind the Wabash Station, 126 North Tenth Street, Columbia, Missouri, on Sundays beginning April 11, 2015 through October 12, 2015, from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM., to provide the community access to fresh nutritious produce, quality goods and unique crafts.
- 2. NVAD will provide the City with the required Certification of Liability Insurance, and agree to endorse CITY as an Additional Insured.
- 3. NVAD will be responsible for trash removal and cleaning of the Wabash Station parking lot.
- 4. This agreement is made solely for the benefit of the party's hereto and not for the benefit of any third party.

Who We Are

The North Village Arts District Farmers and Artisans Market intends to continue as Columbia's Downtown farmers market. Our mission is to help support local farmers and artisans by fostering meaningful relationships between them and the community. To provide the community access to fresh nutritious produce, quality goods and unique crafts. To further enrich our community through fellowship and education with activities, events and workshops for all ages.

Goals

The North Village Arts District Farmers and Artisans Market goal is to complete our mission and to promote business and recreation within the North Village Arts District.

Who Plans the Farmers and Artisans Market

The North Village Arts District Farmers and Artisans Market is coordinated by the North Village Arts District Board of Directors.

Planned Location

Our plan is to use Wabash Station parking lot. See attached maps, pages 7-8. We will also make use of the private parking lot between Artlandish Gallery and PS:Gallery, owned by John Ott, who is involved with the planning of this market and supports the use of his private property.

Planned Dates and Times

The North Village Arts District Farmers and Artisans Market plans to open the market April 11, 2015 and continue each Sunday from 9:00am to 1:00pm until October 12, 2015. The Wabash Parking lot space will be occupied for set up, regular market hours, and tear down each Sunday from 6:30am to 1:30pm.

Insurance

We are required to carry a \$2 million dollar policy for the event, extending coverage to the North Village Arts District and City of Columbia. We will pass along insurance policy information as soon as the policy is complete for 2015. Our agent will also contact you to verify the policy and provide necessary documentation.



Planned Parking

North Village Arts District Farmers and Artisans Market plans to use public parking on the street and in the city parking garages as well as the private parking available between Artlandish and PS:Gallery. We will take necessary steps to ensure our attendees do not park in the First Christian Church's parking lot.

Trash Collection

North Village Arts District Farmers and Artisans Market will take responsibility for trash removal and cleaning of the station parking lot.

2015 Market Participation Fees

As with other farmers markets, there will be fees for vendors to sell their products. Our market is applying as a non-profit organization. Any funds collected will be used to operate the market, provide free educational workshops, entertainment for the community and pay our staff.

Other

North Village Arts District Farmers and Artisans Market staff and board want to ensure that all considerations related to the events at the market are safely executed and in full compliance with the law. We have a detailed emergency plan for the market. We have created policies and procedures with USDA educational guidance materials. We will work closely with the Health Department to ensure all food products are safe and all conditions are sanitary.
