Re: FY16 Solid Waste Rate Increase and Service Changes

Executive Summary

Staff is proposing to amend Chapter 22 of the Code of Ordinances as it relates to solid waste rates and services. The proposed changes include increasing the commercial service collection rates; establishing a section to bill front loading and rear-loading containers at different rates based on associated costs; a section on roll-off containers; and increase landfill tonnage fees and appliance collection and disposal fees. Existing commercial rates were identified by the 2015 Solid Waste Cost of Service and Rate Study completed by MSW Consultants, to be an average 54.7% insufficient to cover associated costs, Roll-off rates 26.4% insufficient and landfill rates 4% insufficient.

Discussion

This proposed amendment will increase the following rates:

- Major appliance curbside pickup from \$18.93 to \$20.31, per appliance, for appliances equipped for use of refrigerants, and from \$12.62 to \$13.56, per appliance, for appliances not requiring refrigerants.
- Major appliances delivered to a designated location at the landfill, from \$18.93 to \$20.31, per appliance, for appliances equipped for use of refrigerants, and \$12.62 to \$13.56, per appliance, for appliances not requiring refrigerants
- Landfill tonnage fee from \$41.00/ton to \$44.00/ton
- In the event landfill scales are temporarily out of commission, any vehicle one ton or larger from \$108.87 each to \$116.82 each
- In the event landfill scales are temporarily out of commission, non-compacted roll-off boxes, trailers greater than eighteen (18) feet in length and truck with haul bed greater than eighteen (18) feet in length from \$217.81 each to \$233.71 each
- In the event landfill scales are temporarily out of commission, compactor trucks and compactor roll-off boxes from \$19.00 per cubic yard capacity to \$20.39 per cubic yard capacity
- Hand pickup of businesses or commercial places, boarding and rooming houses, fraternities and sororities from \$2.45 per collection minute to \$2.64 per collection minute
- Hand pickup of businesses or commercial places, boarding & rooming houses, fraternities and sororities minimum of five (5) minutes from \$12.25 per occurrence to \$13.20 per occurrence

- Front loading construction dumpsters. The City shall set a dumpster at a construction site for a
 fee increasing from \$87.12 to \$88.44. Collection service from the dumpster shall be made
 upon request from \$56.16 to \$61.77 per collection with a minimum (calendar) monthly charges
 from \$56.16 to \$61.77
- Full-sized compactor style roll-off containers from \$85.66 to \$89.94 per collection plus from \$41.00 to \$44.00 per ton with a minimum (calendar) monthly charge of from \$85.66 to \$89.94

- Mini-sized non-compacted style roll-off containers from \$60.90 to \$63.94 per collection plus from \$41.00 to \$44.00 per ton with a minimum (calendar) monthly charge of from \$60.90 to \$63.94
- Per the Solid Waste Cost of Service study recommendations we are proposing to differentiate
 the bulk storage container collection between front loading and rear loading bulk storage
 container collection to account for associated cost differences. We are also phasing the full
 cost rates in over three years. This is the first of three years of proposed commercial rate
 increases.

(a) Customer responsibility. Commercial customers shall comply with the following requirements:

. . .

- (b) Commercial collection methods and rates. The following refuse collection methods and rates shall apply to commercial customers as approved by the director.
 - (1) Commercial hand pickup:
 - a. The service charge for hand pickup of businesses or commercial places, boarding and rooming houses, fraternities and sororities, shall be at the rate of two dollars and forty-five cents (\$2.45) sixty-four cents (\$2.64) per collection minute, or a minimum of five (5) minutes which is equivalent to twelve dollars and twenty-five cents (\$12.25) thirteen dollars and twenty cents (\$13.20) per occurrence. Such collection time shall be computed by the director from time to time and shall be based on the average collection time for such place of business. A notice from the director establishing the average collection time for hand pickup accounts shall be from time to time reestablished. Service to these accounts shall be rendered daily when and where needed, as determined by the director.
 - b. Commercial customers served by hand pickup service, shall conform to container capacity of twenty (20) to thirty-three (33) gallons and weighing, with contents when full, not over fifty (50) pounds, or the equivalent thereof.
 - (2) Bulk storage container collection. Rates per month for bulk storage containers shall be shown in the following table for container sizes indicated and number of collections per week:

Pickup shall be available once daily, except Sundays and legal holidays, and shall be made as determined necessary by the director. The director is authorized to order special collections or extra collections in the event containers are found to be overly filled prior to the regularly scheduled collection date and to direct that the customer be billed in accordance with the provisions of this article.

. . .

(d) Front loading construction dumpsters. The city shall set a dumpster at a construction site upon payment of eighty-seven dollars and twelve cents (\$87.12) for a rate of eighty-eight dollars and forty-four cents (\$88.44). Collection service from the dumpster shall be made upon request at a rate of fifty-six dollars and sixteen cents (\$56.16) sixty-one dollars and seventy-seven cents (\$61.77) per collection with a minimum (calendar) monthly charge of fifty-six dollars and sixteen cents (\$56.16) sixty-one dollars and seventy-seven cents (\$61.77). In the event service is not requested within each thirty (30) days full calendar month following placement, the container may be removed and a new placement

charge will be levied to set the container again. <u>Payment can be required at the time a</u> container is requested to be set.

- (e) Roll-off containers. The fees for such service shall be as follows:
- (1) Full-sized compactor style roll-off containers: Eighty-five dollars and sixty-six cents (\$85.66) Eighty-nine dollars and ninety-four cents (\$89.94) per collection plus forty-one dollars (\$41.00) forty-four dollars (\$44.00) per ton with a minimum (calendar) monthly charge of eighty-five dollars and sixty-six cents (\$85.66) eighty-nine dollars and ninety-four cents (\$89.94).
