## **Executive Summary**

Authorizing the acquisition of necessary easements, and a bid call through the Purchasing division, for construction of the Stadium Boulevard and Old Highway 63 Intersection Improvements project, as shown on the attached site location map and the intersection improvements plan sheet. A public hearing was held on July 6, 2015.

## Discussion

The proposed Stadium Boulevard and Old Highway 63 Intersection Improvements project consists of adding pedestrian facilities and beautification of the intersection, as well as capacity improvements for automobile traffic. The capacity improvements include dual left turn lanes for vehicles travelling from northbound to westbound, and a right turn lane for westbound to northbound traffic.

A temporary construction easement is needed on one (1) tract of land from one (1) property owner. A Right of Way plan showing the proposed easement is attached.

## **Fiscal Impact**

Short-Term Impact: The construction concept cost estimate for this project is \$1,284,000. The cost will be split 50/50 between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission (MHTC). The City portion will be \$642,000 and the funding will come from the 0.25% Capital Improvement Sales Tax approved by voters in 2005.

Long-Term Impact: Upon completion of the project, approximately 700 linear feet of Old Highway 63 south of the intersection will be conveyed from MHTC to the City of Columbia. The additional cost of maintenance for the approximately 700 linear feet of Old Hwy 63 at \$4.60/ ft will be \$3,220 annually.

#### **AN ORDINANCE**

declaring the need to acquire an easement for the construction of improvements at the intersection of Stadium Boulevard and Old Route 63; authorizing acquisition by negotiation or, if necessary, by condemnation; authorizing the City Manager to obtain and execute all instruments necessary for acquisition of such land; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

WHEREAS, the Constitution and Statutes of the State of Missouri and the Home Rule Charter for the City of Columbia, Missouri, authorize the City Council to exercise the power of eminent domain, within or without the City, and among other things, to acquire, and maintain any property, real or personal within or without the City for all public uses or purposes, and to acquire, receive and hold any estate or interest in any such property; and

WHEREAS, the Council deems it necessary for the welfare and improvement of the City and in the public interest that certain private property be acquired by negotiation or by condemnation for public improvement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby declares the need to acquire an easement for the construction of improvements at the intersection of Stadium Boulevard and Old Route 63, described as follows:

A TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT (TCE) across a tract of land as being owned by 1416 College Springs LLC, as recorded in Deed Book 4086, Page 5 of the Boone County Missouri Recorder's Office, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the westernmost corner of Lot 5 of College Springs Plat Two, as recorded in Plat Book 29, Page 4 of the Boone County Missouri Recorder's Office, said corner being on the northerly right-of-way line of Stadium Boulevard (width varies) and the easterly right-of-way line of Old Highway 63 (width varies); Thence along said northerly right-of-way

line South 60 degrees 47 minutes 28 seconds East, 87.74 feet to a point; Thence leaving said northerly right-of-way line North 57 degrees 43 minutes 06 seconds West, 84.02 feet; Thence North 12 degrees 07 minutes 02 seconds East, 133.78 feet to a point on said easterly right-of-way line; Thence along said easterly right-of-way line, South 34 degrees 34 minutes 07 seconds West, 13.09 feet; Thence South continuing along said right-of-way line 12 degrees 07 minutes 02 seconds West, 124.85 feet to the Point of Beginning, and containing 844 square feet inclusive of 681 square feet of existing easements, more or less, according to calculations by HR Green, Inc. during October 2015.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is authorized to acquire the land described in Section 1 by negotiation or by the exercise of the power of eminent domain as set forth in Section 4 hereof.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is authorized to obtain, execute and record all deeds and other instruments necessary to acquire the land described in Section 1.

SECTION 4. If the City cannot agree with the owners, or those claiming an interest in the land described in Section 1, on the proper compensation to be paid for such land, or if the owner is incapable of contracting, is unknown, or cannot be found, or is a non-resident of the State of Missouri, the City Counselor is authorized to petition the Circuit Court of Boone County, Missouri, to acquire the land described in Section 1 by condemnation.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
