Executive Summary

The public improvement project on the attached form is eligible for the administrative public improvement process. Unless the Council wishes to follow the standard public improvement process, staff will proceed with preparing plans and specifications and bidding the project.

Discussion

Under Section 22-72(c) of the City Code, the City Manager is required to report to the City Council any public improvement project that the Manager has determined meets the eligibility requirements of the Code and should follow the administrative public improvement process. Unless the Council determines that the project should follow the standard public improvement process, the Manager may proceed with the administrative process.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The total cost of the project is \$15,000 and will be funded by a donation from the Independent Order of Odd Fellows, Columbia Lodge #207. The appropriation of funds will take place in a separate memo to the City Council.

Project Name and Description: MKT Trailhead Improvements – Independent Order of Odd Fellows, Columbia Lodge #207 Donation

The Parks & Recreation Department is proposing improvements at the MKT trailhead at the Martin Luther King Jr. Memorial at Battle Garden and the MKT trailhead at Forum Nature Area. The proposed improvements at the MKT trailhead at the MLK Jr. Memorial at Battle Garden will include the addition of a new seating area with three benches, trail kiosk, bike rack, bike repair station, and tree planting. The proposed improvements at the MKT trailhead at Forum Nature Area will include seating area improvements on both sides of the trail, information kiosk, bike racks, bike repair

station, and the relocation of an emergency phone to a more accessible area. The project budget is \$15,000 and is funded by a donation from the Columbia Odd Fellows Lodge #207. Park planning staff has worked with the Odd Fellows and this project represents a consensus of Odd Fellows and park staff. Materials for the project will be bid through the City's Purchasing Department, and construction will be completed using a combination of contract and force account labor. Contract labor will be used for the installation of concrete at the two sites, and all other aspects of the project will be completed by force account labor. The project has an estimated completion date of summer 2016, and staff anticipates a small dedication for the project after completion.


