AN ORDINANCE

appropriating funds received from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for the 2011 winter blizzard to the passenger terminal upgrade project at the Columbia Regional Airport; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI,
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The sum of \$166,855.54 is hereby appropriated from the FEMA Blizzard 2011 State Grant Revenue Account No. 110-3810-462.10-00, GFEMA1 to the Passenger Terminal Upgrade Project Expenditures Account No. 554-6288-881.49-90, C44066 for the passenger terminal upgrade project at the Columbia Regional Airport.

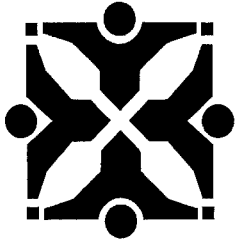

Re: Appropriating FEMA Funds for 2011 Winter Blizzard

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance appropriating funds received from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for the 2011 winter blizzard.

DISCUSSION:

The City of Columbia Public Works department applied for, and received, federal funds in the amount of \$166,855.54, for the 2011 winter blizzard. Staff recommends appropriating these funds to the passenger terminal upgrade project at Columbia Regional Airport. Staff plans to attach a modular building to the terminal to be used as a baggage claims area. The existing baggage claim area will be modified to create additional passenger seating in the Sterile Passenger Holding Area. Combining the two areas will allow the airport to operate a 100+ passenger jet or two regional jets at the same time.

FISCAL IMPACT:

\$166,855.54 is being appropriated from the FEMA Blizzard 2011 State Grant revenue account to the Passenger Terminal Upgrade project expenditure account.
