**AN ORDINANCE**

amending Chapter 11 of the City Code relating to Public Health and Human Services Department fees; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 11 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 11-17. Charges for health services.

Patrons of the health department shall pay the following fees for personal health services. No one will be denied health services for inability to pay.

- Immunization administration fee for state provided vaccines (per visit)..... ~~\$15.00~~ 20.00
- Purchase vaccines ..... vaccine cost plus ~~\$15.00~~ 20.00 administrative charge
- PPD ..... cost plus ~~\$10.00~~ 15.00 administrative charge
- Well woman's exam.....Sliding scaled fee based on income eligibility and Title X/Medicaid guidelines
- STD clinic visit (non-Boone County resident) ..... ~~\$20.00~~ 30.00
- STD clinic visit (Boone County resident) ..... ~~\$10.00~~ 15.00

ARTICLE V. - FOOD CODE

...

Sec. 11-132. Fees.

(a) Food establishments shall pay an annual inspection fee based on their annual gross receipts according to the following schedule:

- (1) Annual Gross Receipts less than \$250,000.00 ..... ~~\$165.00~~ 185.00
- (2) Annual Gross Receipts of \$250,000.00—\$750,000.00 ..... ~~225.00~~ 260.00
- (3) Annual Gross Receipts more than \$750,000.00 ..... ~~420.00~~ 480.00

ARTICLE XIII. - TATTOO ESTABLISHMENTS

...

Sec. 11-362. - Tattoo establishment permits.

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to tattoo another person except at a tattoo establishment which has a current tattoo establishment permit issued by the director.

...

(d) An annual inspection fee of one hundred fifty dollars (~~\$100.00~~ 150.00) shall be collected by the business license administrator at the time the permit is issued.

...

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after October 1, 2012.

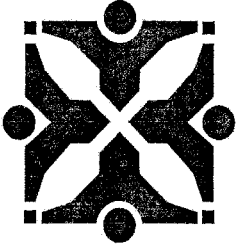

Re: FY2013 Fee Changes Proposed - Health

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

An ordinance amending Chapter 11 of the Code of Ordinances to revise fees for the Public Health and Human Services Department effective October 1, 2012.

**DISCUSSION:**

Annually, as part of the budget process, staff reviews current fees and recommends adjustments based on the cost of services. Fee increases proposed for FY2013 meet the Council objective of increasing the costs recovered for the provision of services.

The following fees are proposed effective October 1, 2012.

Section 11-17 Charges for Health Services

- Increasing immunization administration fees from \$15.00 to \$20.00
- Increasing the administration charge for PPD (TB) testing from \$10.00 to \$15.00
- Increasing the fee for STD clinic visits for Boone County residents from \$10.00 to \$15.00 and non-Boone County Residents residents from \$20.00 to \$30.00

Section 11-132 Fees

- Increasing annual inspection fees for food establishments based on annual gross receipts.
  - 1) Annual Gross Receipts less than \$250,000 from \$165 to \$185
  - 2) Annual Gross Receipts of \$250,000 - \$750,000 from \$225 to \$260
  - 3) Annual Gross Receipts more than \$750,000 from \$420 to \$480

Section 11-362 Tattoo Establishment Permits

- Increasing annual inspection fee from \$100 to \$150

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Additional fees will generate \$69,790 in revenue.
