AN ORDINANCE

accepting a grant from the Missouri Office of Homeland Security for the Fire Department's Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) program; appropriating funds; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to accept a grant from the Missouri Office of Homeland Security in the amount of \$5,000.00 for the Fire Department's Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) program.

SECTION 2. The sum of \$5,000.00 is hereby appropriated from Account No. 110-2342-462.10-00, GCCORP to Account No. 110-2342-513.13-95, GCCORP.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

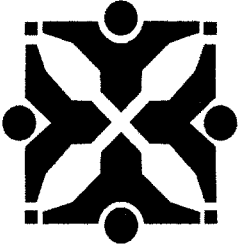

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

This request is to appropriate funds from a reimbursement grant awarded by Missouri Office of Homeland Security (OHS) to support the Columbia Fire Department's CERT program.

DISCUSSION:

The Columbia voluntary Community Emergency Response Team or CERT was formed in 2004 and has actively served, with the support of the Fire Department, in many community events. CERT also trains to maintain a skill level appropriate to helping citizens during a local man-made or natural disaster. The State OHS has released supplementary funds from their fiscal years 2009 and 2010 to be used as reimbursement monies for support of local CERT teams. The Fire Department applied for and was awarded \$5,000 to cover the cost of a 6X12 trailer and supplies to stock the trailer including CERT responder backpacks, medical kits, fire extinguishers, chainsaws, protective vests and masks.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The FY 2012 budget in Fund 110 will increase by \$5,000.
