Water & Light Advisory Boards' Response to Ameren's Request for Letters of Support

Agenda Item No: REP 129-12

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Ameren Missouri is partnering with Westinghouse to apply for Department of Energy (DOE) Small Modular Reactors (SMR) investment funding. Ameren has asked for letters of support for its DOE application for SMR investment funding. Support for this project was discussed at the June Water & Light Advisory Board which resulted in a recommendation that the City Council not support Ameren's Small Modular Reactor Application.

## **DISCUSSION:**

Re:

Ameren has asked for letters of support for its DOE application for SMR investment funding and Associated Electric Cooperatives (AEC) has signed on as supporters for the application. Ameren has been told letters of support for the application will help their chances of being selected by DOE as a recipient for the funding. The Missouri Public Utility Alliance, which Water and Light is a member of, has provided a letter of support for this project. The request for letters of support for Ameren's application for SMR Investment funding from the DOE was brought before the Water and Light Advisory Board at their regular meeting on June 5th. Following are the motions made during the meeting:

Tad Johnsen stated that Ameren has asked for letters of support for their application for Small Modular Reactor (SMR) investment funding from the Department of Energy. The Missouri Public Utility Alliance, which Water and Light is a member of, has provided a letter of support for this project. Discussion followed. Bob Roper made a motion that the Board urge council to officially support Ameren's Small Modular Reactor Application. Motion died for lack of a second. Mr. Roper requested that his motion, stating lack of a second, proceed to council for their consideration.

Tom O'Connor made a motion, seconded by Dick Parker, to recommend to council not to support Ameren's Small Modular Reactor Application. Motion passed with a vote of three in favor and two against.
