AN ORDINANCE

accepting a donation from the Home Fire Sprinkler Coalition to be used by the Fire Department for public education of home sprinkler systems; appropriating funds; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby accepts a \$1,000.00 donation from the Home Fire Sprinkler Coalition to be used by the Fire Department for public education of home sprinkler systems.

SECTION 2. The sum of \$1,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Miscellaneous Revenue Account No. 753-8500-480.53-23 to the Publishing and Advertising Account No. 110-2342-513.43-10.

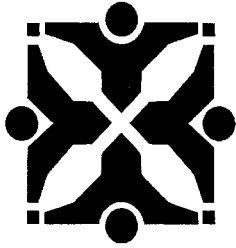

Re: Donation from Home Fire Sprinkler Coalition

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

This request is to accept a stipend donation from the Home Fire Sprinkler Coalition to the Columbia Fire Department for the purpose of making educational material available to the public through local advertising media.

DISCUSSION:

The Home Fire Sprinkler Coalition (HRSC) was awarded a FEMA Fire Prevention and Safety Grant, and part of their program involves awarding stipends to local fire departments who have demonstrated commitment to public education efforts. Columbia Fire Department was chosen as a "Built for Life" Fire Department; we have received and deposited a \$1,000 stipend for use in broadcast or print media to help increase awareness of home sprinkler systems. Upon completion of the program a summary report is to be provided to HRSC for evaluation purposes.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The FY 2013 budget in fund 110 will increase by \$1,000.
