Re: Accepting and appropriating donated funds for J.W. Blind Boone Home Landscaping project

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Since 1998 the restoration of the J.W. Blind Boone Residence has been an ongoing collaborative project between the City of Columbia and the Blind Boone Heritage Foundation. Through these efforts the Blind Boone Home has been structurally stabilized and the exterior has been painted. Ideally, the next phase of the restoration would be the interior of the home. Because the funding needed for the interior is not in place, the committee has decided to focus on the garden area of the home. With the garden area and stage in place, fund raising efforts could take place on the grounds of the actual home. This would allow the community to actually see the work that needs to take place and could assist in raising the rest of the funds needed to complete the project. The John William Boone Heritage Foundation is donating \$16,500 to the City of Columbia to begin work on the landscaping behind the Blind Boone Home.

DISCUSSION:

The Department of Parks and Recreation has agreed to oversee the project. The money will be placed in the Blind Boone Home Project Account which currently has available funds left from last project.
