Re: Service Animals

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Disabilities Commission and the Human Rights Commission recommend that the Council amend Chapter 12 of the City Code to specifically provide that service animals be allowed in places of public accommodation. Staff has drafted an ordinance that would add this provision to Chapter 12.

DISCUSSION:

The Disabilities Commission requested that the City's Human Relations Ordinance, Chapter 12 of the City Code, be amended to specifically provide that service animals be allowed in places of public accommodation. Staff drafted such an amendment based on the 2010 U.S. Department of Justice regulations implementing the Americans with Disabilities Act.

"Service animal" is defined as any dog that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of an individual with a disability, including a physical, sensory, psychiatric, intellectual, or other mental disability.

The proposed ordinance would make it unlawful for any person owning or operating a place of public accommodation to prohibit the use of a service animal by an individual with a disability. The person owning or operating a place of public accommodation may ask an individual with a disability to remove a service animal from the premises if the animal is out of control or is not housebroken.

Both the Disabilities Commission and the Human Rights Commission have reviewed the ordinance and recommend that the Council pass it.
