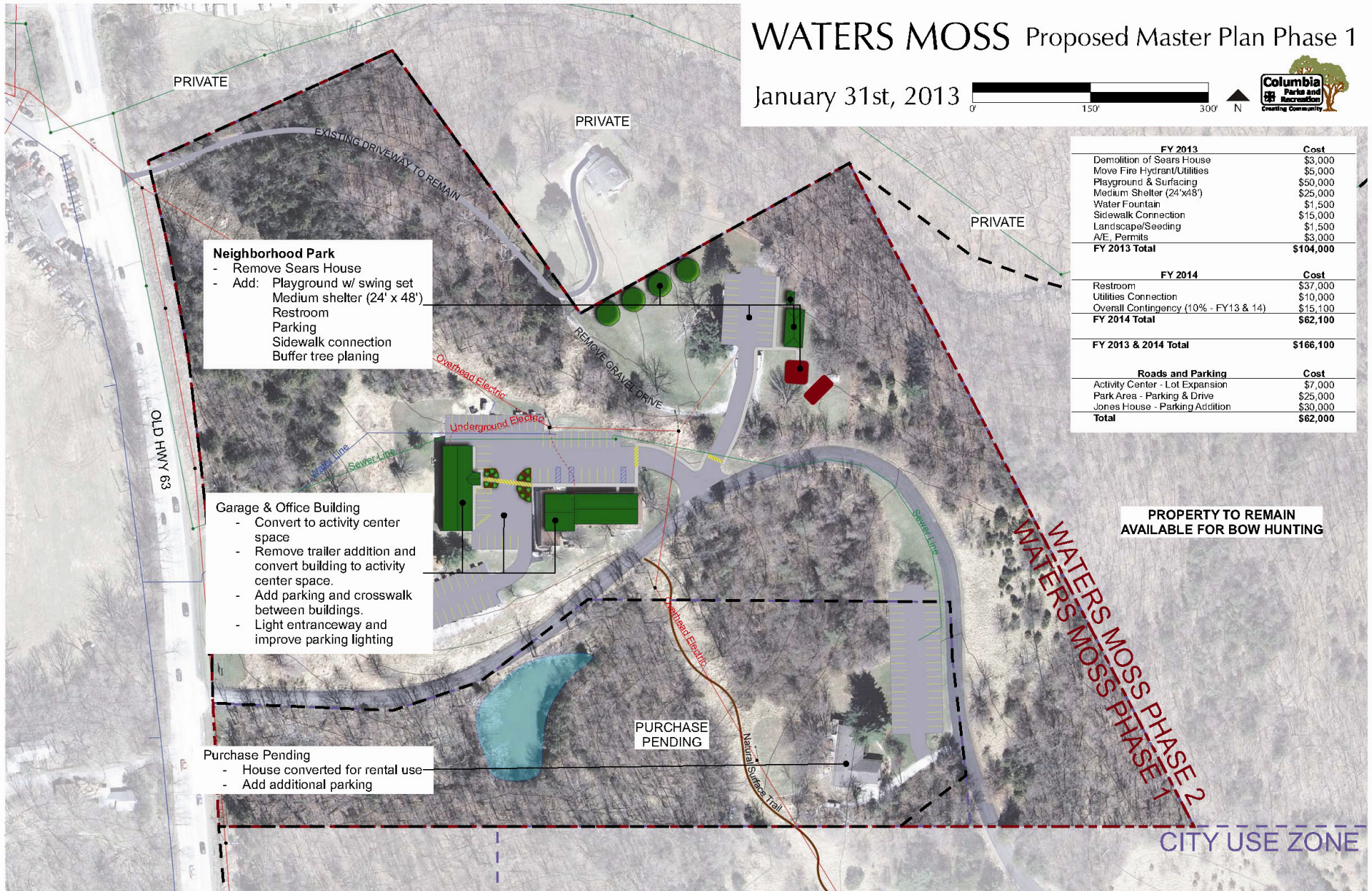
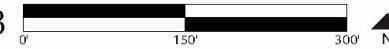






# WATERS MOSS Proposed Master Plan Phase 1

January 31st, 2013



- Neighborhood Park**
- Remove Sears House
  - Add: Playground w/ swing set
  - Medium shelter (24' x 48')
  - Restroom
  - Parking
  - Sidewalk connection
  - Buffer tree planing

- Garage & Office Building**
- Convert to activity center space
  - Remove trailer addition and convert building to activity center space.
  - Add parking and crosswalk between buildings.
  - Light entranceway and improve parking lighting

- Purchase Pending**
- House converted for rental use
  - Add additional parking

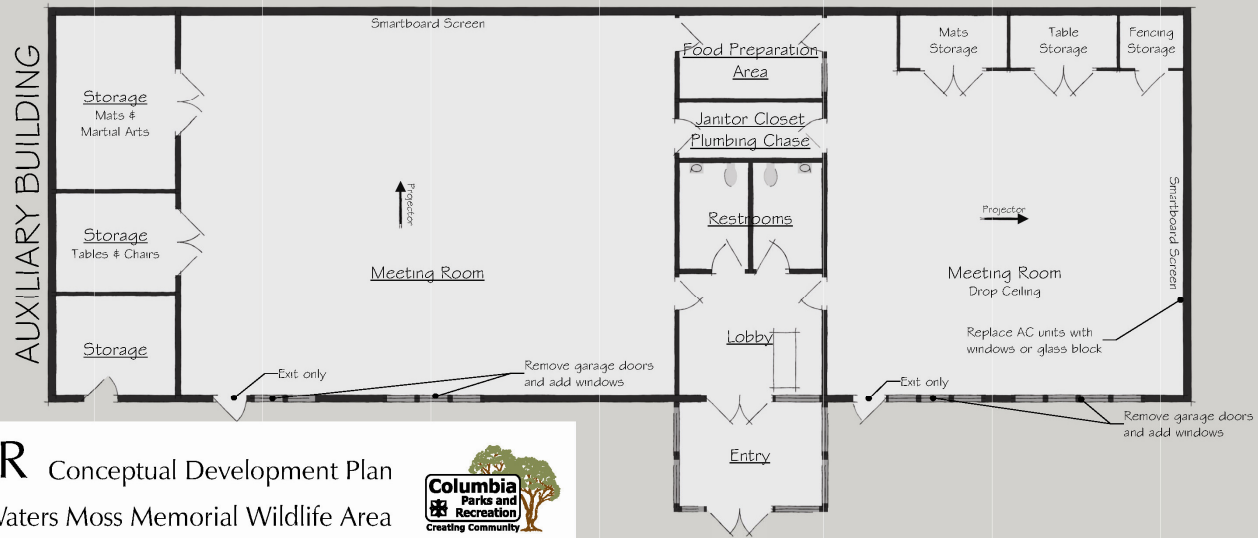
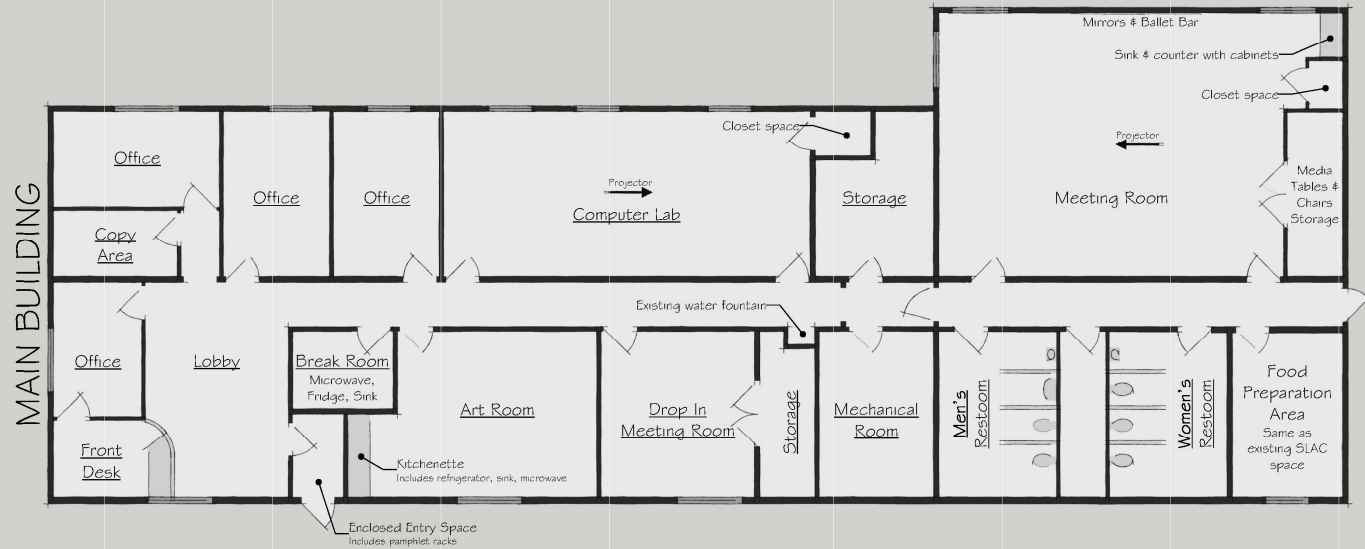

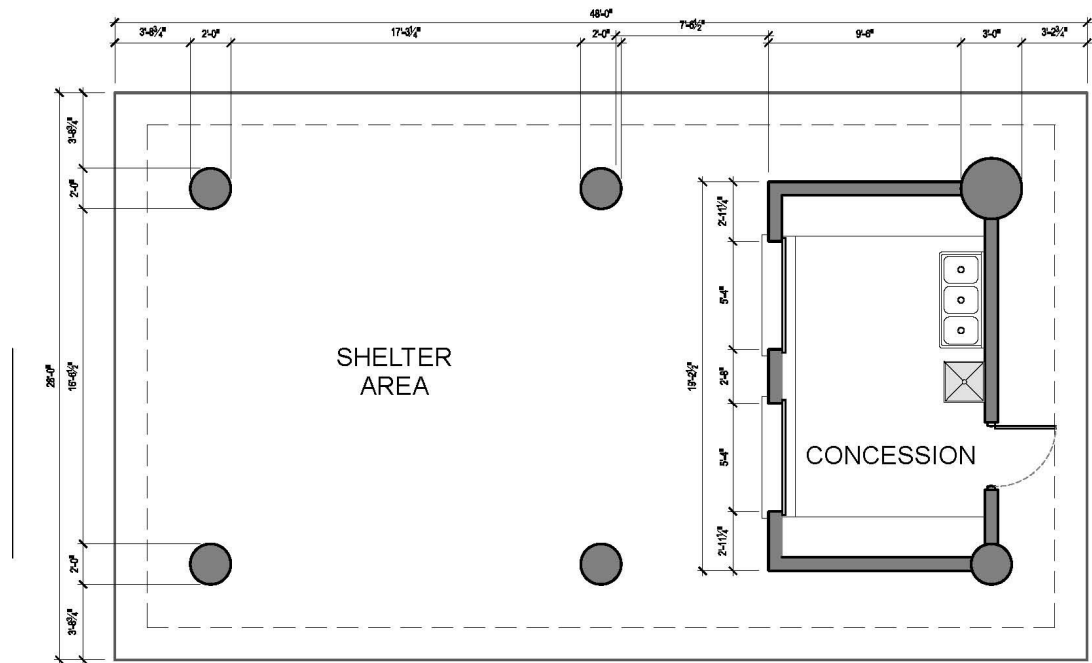

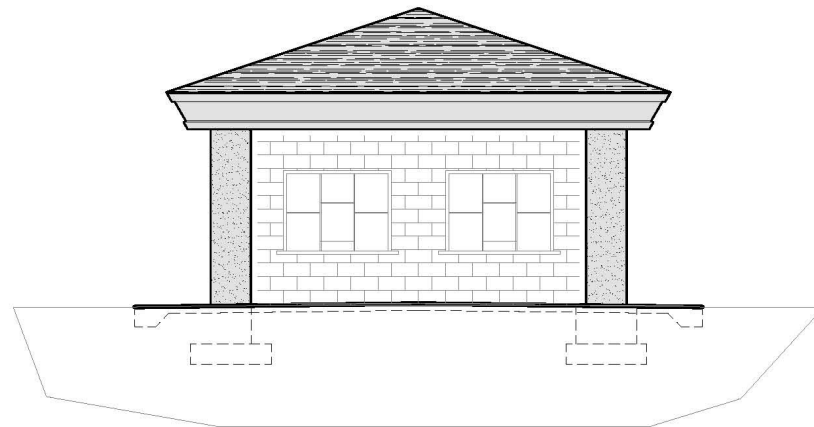

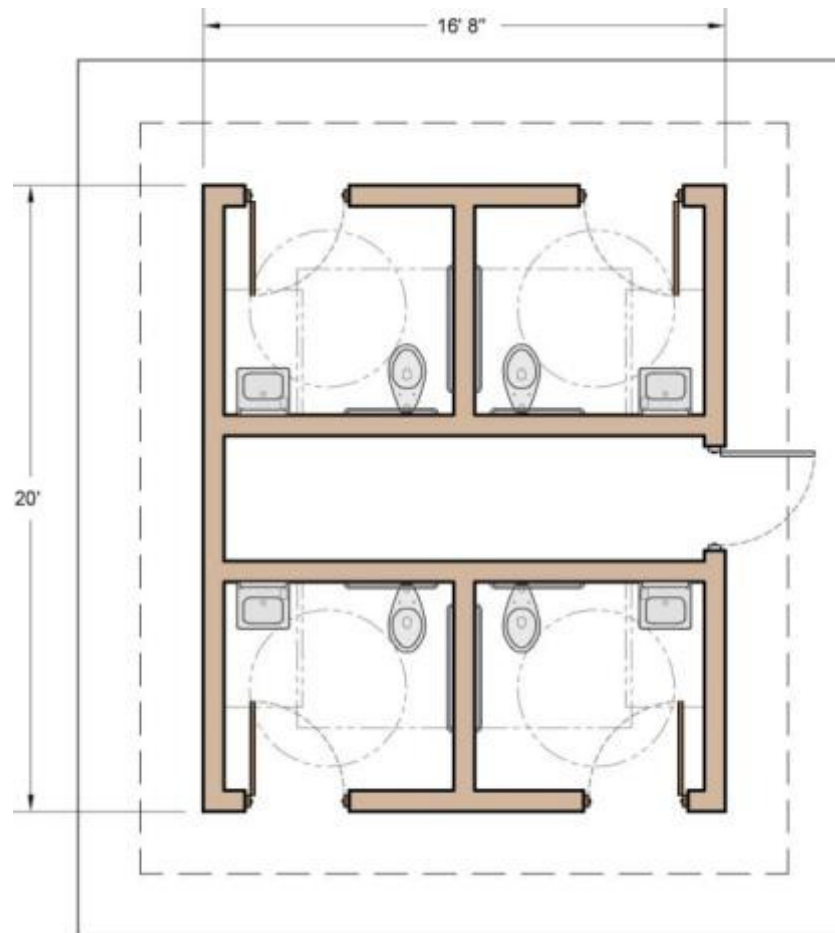




1 FLOOR PLAN

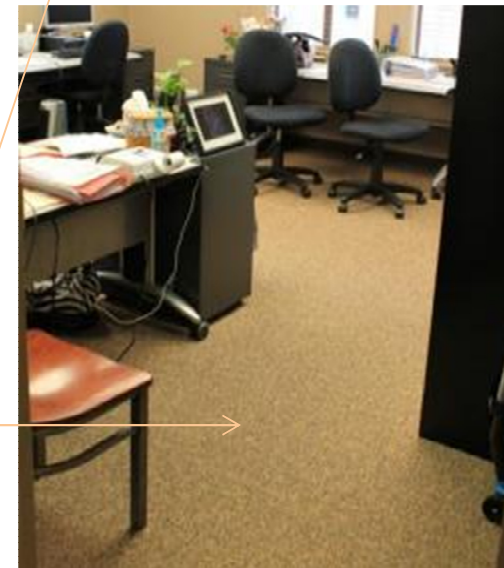

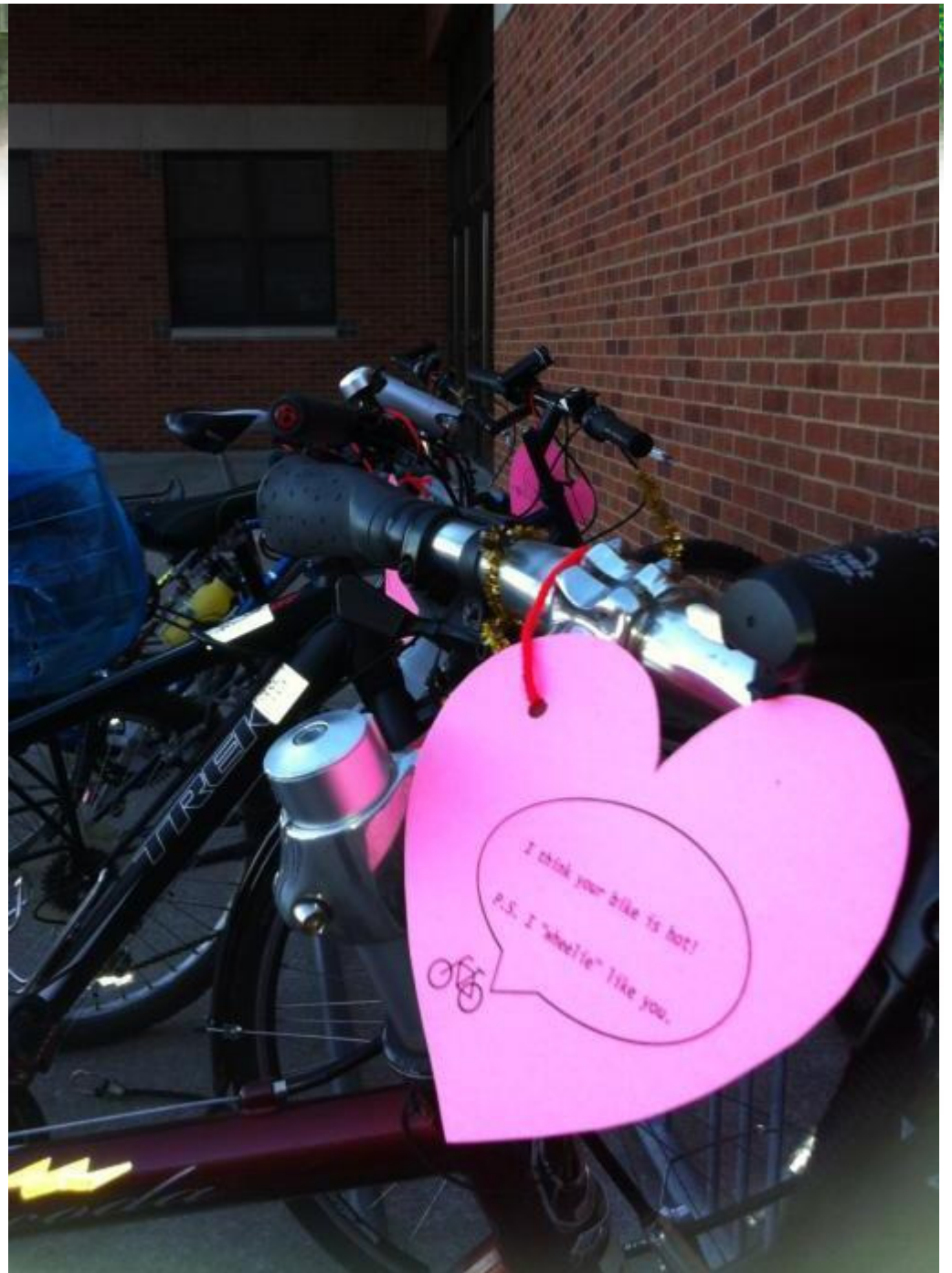
