Re: Parking Issues on Lansing Avenue (CM 3853)

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

Staff has prepared for council consideration a report concerning parking on Lansing Avenue east of Portland Street. There is concern about existing parking on both sides of Lansing Avenue causing issues with travel along Lansing Avenue.

#### DISCUSSION:

At the May 6, 2013 Council meeting, staff was informed of a parking issue developing on Lansing Avenue, and directed to prepare a report for one side parking restriction (Dene to Portland), in addition to existing two side parking prohibition (Keene to Portland). The pavement is 31 feet wide, which would typically allow parking along both sides of the street when vehicles are spaced out. However, the travel along Lansing has been impeded due to the way vehicles are now parking on the north and south side of Lansing Avenue in a compact area.

Staff recommends a parking prohibition on the south side of Lansing Avenue, from Portland Street to Dene Drive, which will allow for better traffic flow in this area. Given the current number of vehicles parking along the street on both sides, there should be adequate space along the north side to accommodate the vehicles.

### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

\$300 from the Street Maintenance budget for materials, equipment, and labor.
