- McKee Street Park located within ½-mile of property
- Lot size: 2 acres
- Current use is a residential property
 - 1940's, 640 sq ft, 2bedroom house, sheds
 - Property fairly open




Zoned R-2 and requests to be PUD




Reed Rezoning

- Proposed use
 - 10 to 12 unit multi-family
 - Parking lot: 17 cars
 - Min percentage of site to remain in open space:
 75%









Reed Rezoning

- McKee St Park
 - 4.5 acre
 - Typical neighborhood park amenities including a playground, open space play field, concrete trail and full-court basketball court.
- Ideal for young families or individuals.
- Staff does not see any adverse impact to McKee Street Park due to this rezoning.

- City Council Public Hearing, approval of master plan, and authorization to proceed with phase I construction - 2nd Council Meeting in March.












