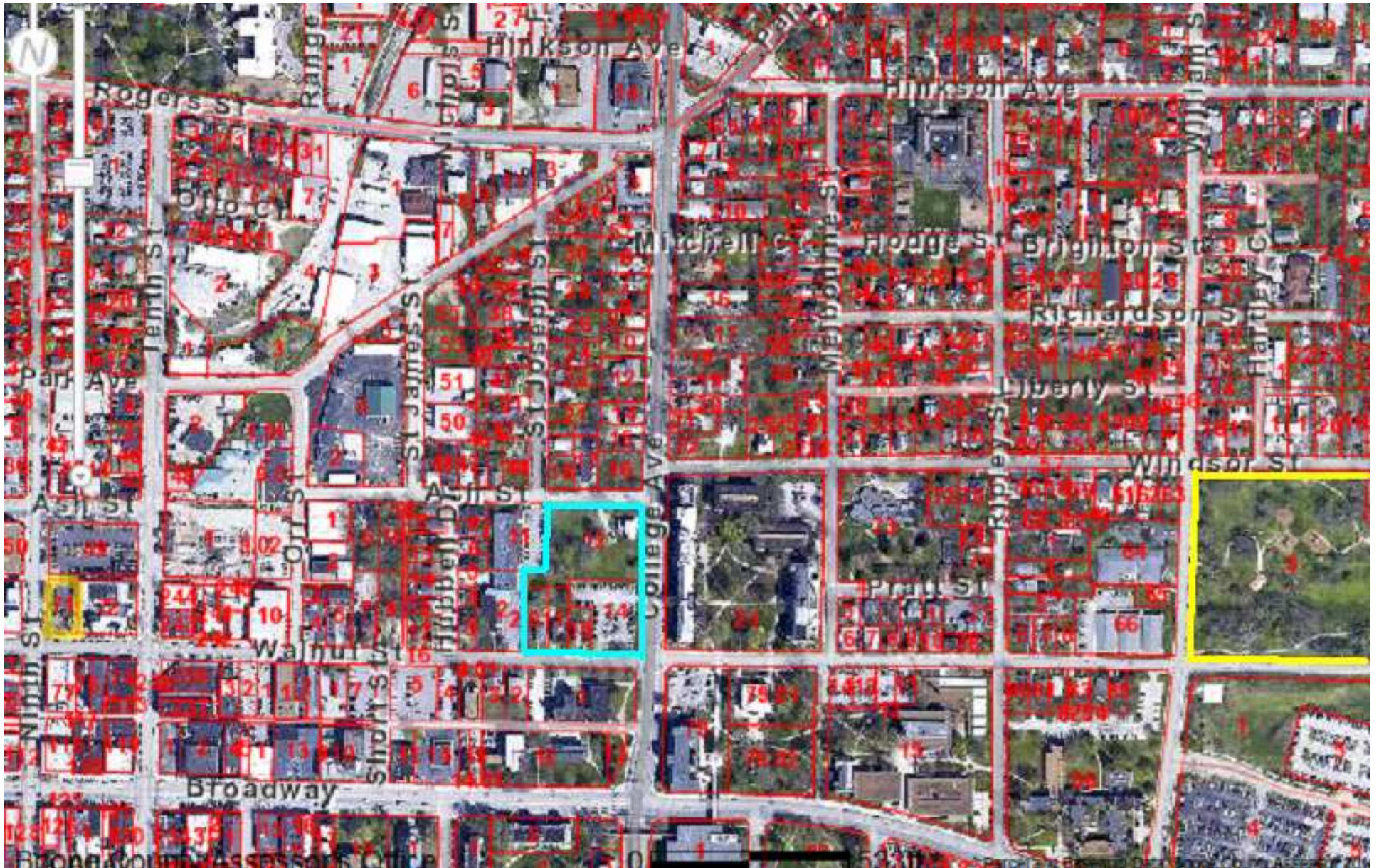
# College & Walnut, LLC- Rezoning

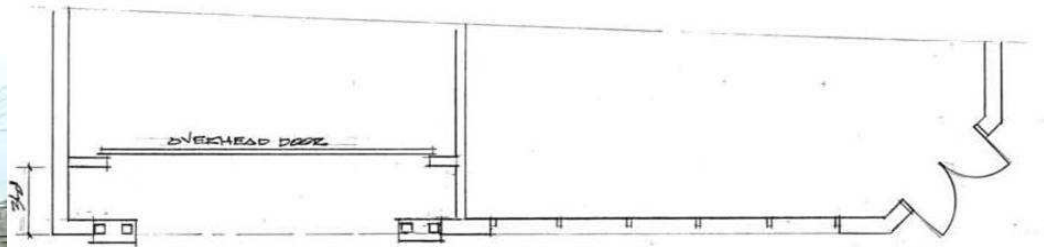
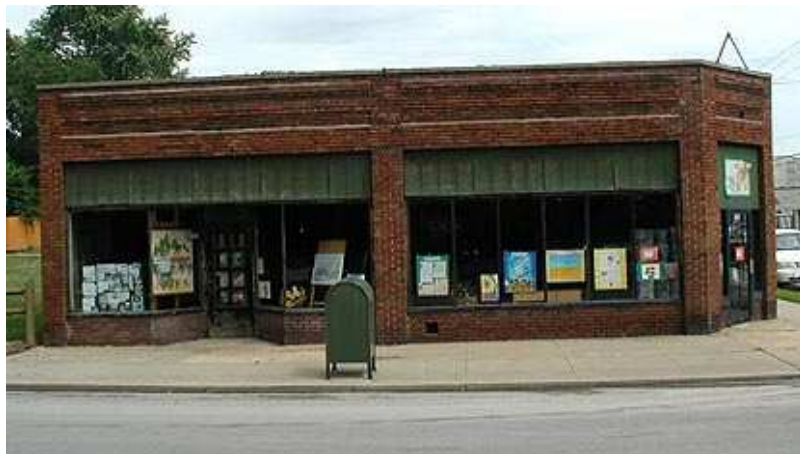




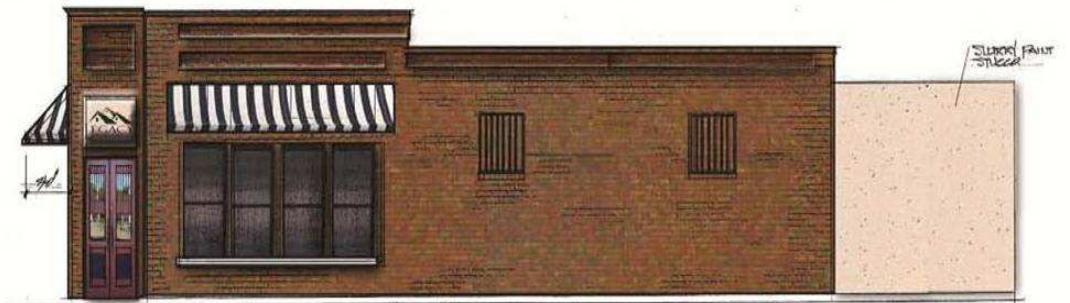
## **College & Walnut, LLC- Rezoning**
