- Costing allocation—determining direct costs for major program categories and allocating indirect costs
- Develop cost of service model—incorporate and allocate direct and indirect costs to make management decisions on pricing of services
 Pricing policy analysis—review current pricing policies, review of financial performance of programs, and review of current cost recovery percentages

- User fee design—utilizing the cost of service model, recommendations for revised user fee schedule
