CITY COUNCIL MEETING - COLUMBIA, MISSOURI
APRIL 27, 2005

INTRODUCTORY

The City Council of the City of Columbia, Missouri met for a special session at 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 27, 2005, in the Council Chamber of the City of Columbia, Missouri. The roll was taken with the following results: Council Members HUTTON, LOVELESS, NAUSER, ASH, HINDMAN, CRAYTON, and JANKU were present. The City Manager, City Counselor and City Clerk were present.

NEW BUSINESS

Mayor Hindman explained that the purpose of the special meeting was to vote on a motion to hold a closed meeting immediately following the work session scheduled for 6:00 p.m., April 27, 2005, in the fourth floor conference room of the Daniel Boone Building. The purpose of the closed meeting was to discuss litigation involving the City; the lease or purchase of real estate by the City where public knowledge of the transaction might adversely affect the legal consideration therefor; and the hiring, firing, disciplining or promoting of employees pursuant to the provisions of Section 610.021 (1), (2) and (3) RSMo.

Mr. Hutton made the motion that Council adjourn to a closed session on Wednesday, April 27th in the fourth floor conference room of the Daniel Boone Building to discuss litigation matters, the lease or purchase of real estate by the City where public knowledge of the transaction might adversely affect the legal consideration therefor, and the hiring, firing, disciplining or promoting of employees as authorized by Section 610.021 (1), (2) and (3) RSMo. The motion was seconded by Mr. Janku with the vote recorded as follows: VOTING YES: HUTTON, LOVELESS, NAUSER, ASH, HINDMAN, CRAYTON, JANKU. VOTING NO: NO ONE. Motion passed.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:05 p.m.
