Sewer Rates

City Manager Bill Watkins introduced Sewer Maintenance Superintendent Bill Weitkemper so that he could discuss his billing ideas in advance of Council's consideration of ordinance changes that evening. Based on an audit of utility customer accounts, he said that many more units should be assessed a base charge, under current ordinances. He said that current billing practices create some customer inequities. Council and City discussed continuing concerns with the ordinance and proposed changes. Council is interested in billing system examples from other cities.
