Douglass Bulldogs Baseball Registration Ongoing

It's time to sign up for summer baseball! The Columbia Parks and Recreation Department and Douglass Athletic Association are accepting registrations for Douglass Bulldogs baseball. The Douglass baseball program is an instructional league for both boys and girls between the ages of 5 and 10. The league is non-competitive; having fun and learning to play baseball are the program's main goals.

The league starts June 9 and runs through July 18. Games will be played on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday evenings with some possible Friday evening games at Douglass Park (Providence and Rogers Streets). Games will start at 5:30 p.m. or later.

Players ages 5 and 6 will play tee ball, players ages 7 and 8 play coach pitch, and players ages 9 and 10 play kid pitch. Efforts will be made to allow teammate requests.

Registration is \$20 per child; the fee includes a league shirt and hat. Registrations postmarked after April 5 will be charged \$25 per child.
