

4. Crane Rezoning


- 320 acre tract of land owned by the City.

- Within half-mile boundary of the Bear Creek Trail and Cosmo Park.
- Rezoning due to annexation into the City.

4-a. Creasy Springs Rd Rezoning


- 2.5 acre tract of land on Creasy Springs Road
- Within half-mile boundary the Bear Creek Trail and Cosmo Park.
- Rezoning due to annexation into the City.
- Recommendation: Staff does not foresee any adverse impacts to the park.

4-b. McAlester Berry Rezoning

- Total site is 10.79 acres
- Divide into two tracts and rezone smaller tract
- Rezone from R-1 to O-P
- Operate long term care hospital


- Recommendation: Staff does not foresee any adverse impacts to the park.
