### 1<sup>st</sup> Ward

- Again St. Park - Fabricated and installed new main park sign.
- Armory Sports Center
  - Completed flooring project.
  - Renovated upstairs restroom.
- Flat Branch Park - Began renovation of the spraygrounds.
- Lee Elementary School - Executed contract with Columbia Public Schools to fund the replacement of the 20+ year old playground equipment as part of the Fiscal Year 2013 Annual City/School Co-op Playground project.

### 2<sup>nd</sup> Ward

- Albert-Oakland Park
  - Completed soil excavation in preparation for new ballfield fencing.
  - Completed setting the ballfield fence poles and painting the foul poles.
  - Installed ballfield electrical control panel, rewired field light poles, and began conduit installation on fields.
  - Ordered pre-fab restroom.
- Bear Creek Trail - Installed 52 wayfinding signs on the trail and connectors for GetAbout project.
- Cosmo Park
  - Repaired the entrances to the parking lot by football field #4 by replacing the asphalt with concrete.
  - Ordered pre-fab restroom.
  - Antimi Sports Complex - Completed construction of new batting cage behind Black Field.
- LA Nickell Clubhouse
  - Completed interior demolition for remodel.
  - Completed rough plumbing and electrical work.
  - Rebuilt all interior walls.
  - Completed sheetrock replacement in phase 1.
  - Installed and grouted all floor and wall tile in both restrooms and hallway.
  - Refurbished ceiling beams in lobby and pro shop.
  - Painted bathroom, lobby, and pro shop.
  - Installed and trimmed new windows.
  - Removed concrete section outside south lobby door.

### 3<sup>rd</sup> Ward

- Brown Station Park - Fabricated and installed new park sign.
- Lions-Stephens Park
  - Removed retaining walls and old fitness stations.
  - Began excavation work.
- Stephens Lake Park - Hindman Discovery Garden - Ordered interpretive signs.

## 4<sup>th</sup> Ward

- Bonnie View Nature Sanctuary
  - Fabricated and installed 7 new picnic tables.
  - Ordered pre-fab restroom.
- Fairview Park - Completed construction of the concrete curbing and driveway at Fairview parking lot.
- MKT Trail
  - Removed old fitness stations along trail.
  - Installed and/or reinstalled 10 wayfinding signs on the trail for GetAbout project.
- Scott's Branch Trail
  - Completed boardwalk construction, except stair railing.
  - Completed installation of the bridge at Dublin Park.
- Twin Lakes Recreation Area
  - Awarded bids for new park entry sign and water play features for Little Mates Cove.
  - Completed installation of the dog park double entry gate and fencing.
  - Constructed gravel trail through dog park.
  - Completed construction of concrete sidewalks from dog park double entry gate to small dog park and lakeside off-leash areas.
  - Removed asphalt and completed installation of concrete ADA parking.
  - Completed water service installation for dog wash station and ticket booth building.
  - Renovated Little Mates Cove (LMC) bathhouse for ADA compliance.
  - Completed replacement of LMC boardwalk.

## 5<sup>th</sup> Ward

- Jay Dix Station (5<sup>th</sup> Ward - pending annexation) - Put playground out to bid.

## 6<sup>th</sup> Ward

- Grindstone Creek Trail - A pre-council meeting on the trail project was held on January 22. Council directed park staff to prepare a formal report to Council summarizing key options and various City commissions' recommendations.
- New Haven Elementary School - Executed contract with Columbia Public Schools to fund construction of a 13,000 ft. long walking/running gravel track as part of the Fiscal Year 2013 Annual City/School Co-op Playground project.
- Shepard Blvd. Elementary School - Executed contract with Columbia Public Schools to fund construction of a new baseball/softball backstop and improvements to the existing one as part of the Fiscal Year 2013 Annual City/School Co-op Playground project.
- Waters-Moss Memorial Wildlife Area
  - Held interested parties meeting on site January 31.
  - Removed old furniture from offices.
  - Acquired 5.3 acre tract within the park boundaries.
