New Shelter/Concession at Cosmo

Citywide

- Comprehensive Master Plan - Completed draft plan and held public hearing at July 15 Council Meeting.

1st Ward

- Again St. Park - Installed new main park sign; removed old and installed new fitness equipment.
- Armory Sports Center - Completed flooring projects and renovated upstairs restroom.
- Douglass Park
 - Douglass High School/Park Infrastructure - Completed sidewalk and fencing installation.
 - Pool - Completed ADA pool lift installation.
 - Completed demolition of house at 405 N. 5th St. and installation of park security cameras.
- Flat Branch Park - Completed spraygrounds renovation.
- Paquin Park - Completed replacement of concrete patio and walkways for ADA compliance.

2nd Ward

- Albert-Oakland Park
 - Completed renovation of ballfields and resurfacing tennis courts.
 - Completed ADA pool lift installation.
 - Completed installation of new restroom, construction of connecting sidewalks, and replacement of missing C. M. Albert Memorial Park signs.
- Bear Creek Trail
 - Completed installation of 52 wayfinding signs on the trail/connectors for GetAbout.
 - Completed major repairs and reconstruction of storm-damaged boardwalk (insurance claim).
- Cosmo Park
 - Replaced asphalt with concrete to repair parking lot by football field #4.
 - Completed installation of pre-fab restroom to serve soccer and football fields.
 - Completed construction of shelter/concession building to serve football/lacrosse fields.
 - Began construction of block wall restroom to serve football/lacrosse fields.
 - Rainbow Softball Center - Completed infield renovations of six fields and overlay of the asphalt on the north interior walkways from the concession stand to the outfield fencing.
 - Antimi Sports Complex - Completed ag-lime conversion of Red and Blue Fields.
 - L. A. Nickell Clubhouse - Completed interior renovation.
- Parkade Park - Replaced 40 linear feet of sidewalk to meet ADA slope requirements.

3rd Ward

- Battle Avenue Property (not yet annexed) - Acquired 3.18-acre tract for future park next to high school.
- Brown Station Park - Completed new main park sign installation.
- Hominy Creek Trail - Completed Phase I trail construction from Green Valley Drive to Lansing Drive.
- Lake of the Woods Pool - Completed ADA pool lift installation.
- Lions-Stephens Park - Completed trail renovation, removal of old and installation of nine new fitness stations, and construction of a rain garden.
- Stephens Lake Park
 - Hindman Discovery Garden - Completed garden and held dedication on October 16, 2012.

4th Ward

- Bonnie View Nature Sanctuary - Completed park development.
- Fairview Park - Completed construction of green paver parking lot.
- MKT Trail
 - Installed 10 wayfinding signs on the trail for GetAbout project.
 - Stadium Access - Removed old fitness stations along the trail and installed eight fitness stations.
 - 3M Flat Branch-Hinkson Creek Wetlands - Renovated, prepped, and planted shelter green roof.
- Scott's Branch Trail - Completed boardwalk construction, bridge installation, and trail construction from Weaver Drive to Scott Blvd.
- Twin Lakes Recreation Area
 - Little Mates Cove - Completed renovation of water play area, bathhouse, and ticket booth.
 - Dog Park - Completed renovation of dog park, including construction of new area for small dogs.
 - Park - Constructed rain garden.

5th Ward

- Cosmo-Bethel Park - Completed resurfacing of 12 tennis courts (co-op project with School District).
- Greenbriar Trail Connector (GetAbout Columbia Project) - Hosted dedication on June 26, 2013.
- Jay Dix Station
 - Completed playground installation, fitness station installation, and basketball court construction.
 - Annexation of property was approved at the August 19, 2013 Council Meeting.

6th Ward

- Hinkson Creek Trail - Secured a \$100,000 RTP Grant award to repair the bridge at Capen Park.
- Gans Creek Recreation Area - Completed demolition of house at 3350 E. Gans Road.
- Grindstone Creek Trail - Completed the public input process and received project approval at the August 19, 2013 Council Meeting.
- Waters-Moss Memorial Wildlife Area
 - Acquired 5.3 acre tract within the park boundaries.
 - Completed demolition and began interior renovation work on the former office and garage buildings.
