



The Greenbriar Trail is a .5 mile paved, shared-use trail located in the southwest corner of Columbia, MO and connects to both the MU Recreation Trail and popular MKT Trail. The scenic trail links 1,500 neighborhood residences near Green Meadows Rd. to Columbia's Trail System, the University of Missouri, and downtown retail locations. The Greenbriar Trail also provides opportunities for non-motorized transportation options to students attending Rock Bridge High School. The Greenbriar Trail expands the network of Columbia's walking and biking opportunities increasing the choices for both safe and fun travel options.
