


Stadium and Old 63 Intersection Improvements
Interested Parties Meeting
Tuesday, February 17, 2015, 5:30 P.M.

PURPOSE OF TODAY'S MEETING

Thank You for taking time to attend this meeting. This is an informal open house style meeting to inform local residents and other interested persons about the proposed intersection improvement project. This meeting is an opportunity for citizens to ask questions and offer input regarding the proposed project, prior to a formal Public Hearing which will be held by the City Council at a later date.

PROJECT INFORMATION

- The concept includes adding pedestrian facilities and beautification of the intersection, as well as capacity improvements for automobile traffic. The capacity improvements include dual left turns for those travelling from northbound to westbound, and a right turn lane for westbound to northbound traffic.
- Currently this signalized intersection has no marked crosswalks or pedestrian signals.
- Stadium Boulevard is classified as an Expressway, and Old 63 is classified as a Minor Arterial in the June 2014 CATSO Major Roadway Plan.
- Construction concept cost estimate for this project is \$1,284,000. The cost will be split 50/50 between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission (MHTC). The City portion will be \$642,000 and the funding will come from the 0.25% Capital Improvement Sales Tax approved by voters in 2005.
- The City of Columbia will serve as the lead agency for the design, contract administration, utility coordination, and easement acquisition for this project.
- Construction is expected to be begin in 2015.
- Upon completion of the project, approximately 700 linear feet of Old 63, south of the intersection, will be conveyed from the MHTC to the City of Columbia.
