



Columbia Water & Light Final Application Solar Electric System Rebate Program

Investing in your energy efficiency

Columbia Water & Light must have on file:

- A Pre-Application for the Solar Electric System Rebate Program must be on file
- A signed copy of the Interconnection & Net Metering application
- Columbia Water & Light approval of the project

You must submit with this final application:

- Paid receipts for the system. The receipt must list the model numbers for the installed equipment.
- A copy of the electrical permit from the City of Columbia Protective Inspection division must be submitted along with the rebate application.

The rebate application form and receipts must be submitted to Columbia Water and Light within six months of the solar electric system's installation. Incomplete or incorrect applications will have thirty days to provide the correct information or risk losing their place in the rebate funding process.

Columbia Water and Light reserves the right to inspect the installed equipment before the rebate is finalized.

One-time rebates are available for qualifying electric customers. Rebates are offered on a first-come, first-served basis as funding is available each fiscal year.
