

NOTICE FOR PUBLIC COMMENT AND HEARING

FISCAL YEAR 2016 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ACTION PLAN

The Columbia City Council will hold a public hearing on July 17, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 701 E. Broadway, to consider the City's 2017 Annual Action Plan. The Council will also respond to any comments concerning the plan subsequent to the July 17, 2017 meeting. Copies of the draft document are available at the Community Development Department, 500 E. Walnut, Suite 108. Following the hearing, public comments will be accepted until 5:00 P.M. July 20, 2017. The final document will be submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for approval by no later than July 21, 2017, along with public comment received and responses to those comments. The Community Development Action Plan is prepared to meet the needs, priorities, objectives, and implementation strategies outlined in the City's 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan document for the expenditure of funds from the Department of Housing and Urban Development in the City of Columbia. Funds budgeted to be received by the City from HUD during the 2017 Plan Year include \$837,401 of Community Development Block Grant funding and \$435,421 of HOME Investment Partnership Act Funding. Proposed CDBG and HOME activities for the 2017 plan period are listed below.
