MUNICIPAL COURT OPERATING ORDER #2 IS AMENDED AND UPDATED AS OF March 21, 2018


The Court, on its own motion, makes the following General Orders with respect to the administration of the Court:

1. The City of Columbia has employed qualified persons to serve as the city's probation officer to provide probation and rehabilitation services for persons placed on probation for violation of any ordinance of the city, specifically including the offense of operating or being in physical control of a motor vehicle while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or narcotic drugs. This judicial order of approval allows the following City of Columbia positions; Probation Officer and Court Services Analyst; and qualified persons in these positions may serve in a proper role and function as the probation office for the city for the purposes set forth in Missouri Revised Statute section 559.607.1.
2. The Probation Officer and Court Services Analyst or approved acting position shall remain an employee of the City of Columbia Missouri for all administrative and employment purposes.
3. Pursuant to the authority granted by Missouri Revised Statute Sections 559.604 and 559.607.1, all persons found guilty or pleading guilty to ordinance violations within the City of Columbia, Missouri and placed on probation by a Municipal Court Judge subject to 559.604 and Missouri Supreme Court Rules:

The person placed on probation shall contribute not less than thirty dollars or more than fifty dollars per month to the City of Columbia for providing him or her with supervision and rehabilitation services. The amount of the contribution shall be determined by the sentencing court. The defendant shall pay this service fee at the time the defendant is placed on probation unless exempted in whole or in part as set forth in 559.604, or other good cause is provided to the Court.

- a. Failure to pay this fee as ordered by the Court will be grounds for a probation violation hearing.
 - b. If the probationer does not comply with their order of probation and therefore requires the probation officer to take further action in the defendant's case, such as issuing probation violation hearing notices, appearing at probation violation hearings, preparing arrest warrants etc. the defendant may be order to pay the court service fee for every month in which the Court's probation officer is required to take some action in the defendant's court case as set forth in 559.604 and subject to Missouri Supreme Court Rules.
4. The Municipal Division Court Clerk is hereby ordered to provide a copy of this updated order to the Missouri Board of Probation and Parole. The Municipal Division Court Clerk is also ordered to send a copy of this order to members of the Missouri Bar who regularly appear in this court and is to post a copy of this order on the Court page of the City of Columbia Website and on the outside of the George F. Nickolaus Courtroom 600 East Broadway Columbia Missouri.
