# **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

As part of the FY2012 budget process, the Columbia Parks and Recreation Department evaluated existing fees and is proposing a number of increases. The proposed fees are based on both market research and internal staff review.

Fee increases are proposed in the following areas: shelter reservations, park special use fees, swim lessons, lifeguard certification, golf course green fees, golf course annual passes, golf course punch cards, and summer day camp (Camp Adventure). Specific increases are detailed in the discussion portion of the memo below. In addition to increases in established fees, the department is proposing a limited number of "new" fees at the ARC, Armory and several program areas (Aquatics, Community Recreation and Oak Tours).

The proposed changes to the fee ordinance, if approved, are expected to generate an additional \$62,900 in Revenue for Recreation Services Fund. The proposed increase in revenue has already been included in the FY2012 base budget numbers.

# **DISCUSSION:**

The proposed fee schedule for FY 2012 addresses the adjustment of existing fees and establishment of new fees as follows. Listed below are only the fees that will be adjusted or created by approval of this proposal.

Shelter and park special use fees were last increased in the fiscal Year 2010 budget. Swim lesson fees have not been increased since the FY 2006 budget.
