

Volunteer Position Description

Position Title: CoMo Bike Co-op Volunteer

Department/Division: Columbia Parks and Recreation

Purpose: Staff supervised volunteers will assist with prep and implementing a youth Earn-a-Bike program involving bicycle refurbishment, bicycle education and community service. Additionally, volunteers will assist Columbia's low-to moderate income cyclists with bicycle maintenance needs.

Requirements:

- Knowledge or willingness to learn basic to advanced bike repair skills
- Physical skills to assist with trail/bike lane maintenance and community event set up
- Ability to do hands-on work stripping bike parts and lifting light objects

All volunteers working with the youth Earn-a-Bike program will be required to have a background check.

Task: Assist with bicycle repair for youth Earn-a-Bike program and walk-in/mobile bike repair. Volunteers will also assist with community special events/outreach activities and repurposing bicycle parts.

Dates:

- First Sunday of the month, afternoon hours.
- Monday afternoons/evening
- Special event dates will vary and will include week nights and weekends.

Location: Most volunteers will be scheduled for work at the Amory Sport Center, 701 E. Ash. Community service and special event locations will vary.
