Position Title: Instructors / Leaders for a Youth Jump Rope & Double Dutch Group

Department/Division: Parks & Recreation / Community Recreation

Purpose: To lead & organize practices. Be a positive role model to the youth involved.

Requirements: Consistent, good with children. Someone at least 20 years of age, active and willing to demonstrate. People that are really into the Columbia community wanting to make this program a success. Prefer someone that can already jump rope & double Dutch, but that certainly is not a requirement. People have “learned on the job” in the past.

Task: Come into practices with a plan, Facilitate, choreograph routines, keep attendance, provide instruction, find performance opportunities. This person would also help promote the program so it can grow.

Dates: Willing to work around the schedule and availability of the volunteer(s). Thinking of 1-2 days a week for the group would be great for an hour at a time.
