Section 112-191; Ord. 20965; Amending Chapter 24 of the City Code to add a section pertaining to curbside mailbox placement and parking prohibitions

AN ORDINANCE

amending Chapter 24 of the City Code to add a section pertaining to curbside mailbox placement and parking prohibitions; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 24 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 24-19. Curbside mailbox placement; parking prohibitions.

(a) Where on-street parking interferes with curbside mail delivery, the property owner shall either request that the traffic engineer prohibit parking near the mailbox or move the mailbox so that mail carriers may deliver mail without leaving their vehicles.

(b) Upon request of a property owner, the traffic engineer is authorized to prohibit parking near mailboxes by either placing an official sign prohibiting parking or marking the curb with official yellow paint.

Sec. 24-19-24-20. Penalty.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this article shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.

Secs. 24-20-24-21— 24-30. - Reserved.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
