# Jay Dix Station Park dedication and ribbon cutting



May 3, 2015



Jay Dix Station is the result of a successful collaboration between the City of Columbia and Boone County. The 30-acre tract is owned by the County. In 2009, the County and City entered into a park operating agreement, with the City taking responsibility for the development and maintenance of a park at Jay Dix Station. The portion of the MKT Trail that runs through the park remains under the County jurisdiction.

The park features a train theme and includes a small neighborhood shelter, basketball court, playground, fitness equipment, multi-use fields and mountain bike skills course accessible from the MKT. Jay Dix Station offers nearby neighborhoods a great place to gather and play.

Project funding in the amount of \$125,000 was made possible by the voter-approved Park Sales Tax. We appreciate the continued support by Columbia citizens for parks, as well as the valuable partnership with Boone County, making projects such as this one possible.

#### History of Jay Dix Station

The original name of Jay Dix Station was Turner Station. When trains still ran on the Missouri-Kansas-Texas Railway, the area was a stop for livestock loading. There wasn't an actual building at this location, but there was a stockyard close by, and farmers loaded their livestock for shipping at Turner Station.

In 2002, Boone County lost esteemed medical examiner, Dr. Jay Dix, who had served the County for more than 20 years. Boone County Commissioners decided to memorialize Dr. Dix by naming a County entity in his honor. They chose the area at the MKT Trail, citing Dr. Dix's love of the outdoors, physical fitness and nature. A proclamation issued in December 2002 renamed Turner Station to Jay Dix Station because of Dr.



Dix's interest in the MKT Trail and his dedicated service to the people of Boone County.
