Grindstone Creek Trail

Length 1.75 miles, out and back

This 1.75-mile concrete trail routes from Grindstone Nature Area east under Old 63 through Waters-Moss Memorial Wildlife Area. The trail generally follows Grindstone Creek to the confluence of the north and south forks, and then angles north to McGuire Blvd. At Grindstone Nature Area, it connects to the Hinkson Creek Trail. No unauthorized motorized vehicles are allowed on the trail. The trail experiences moderate daily recreational and commuter use with increased traffic on weekends.
