# **Hominy Branch Trail**

# Length 2.9 miles, out and back

Hominy Creek Trail begins at the east end of Green Valley Drive and routes to the north of Clark Lane up to Lillian Drive. The trail passes under Highway 63, East Broadway/Route WW, and Interstate 70. Hominy Creek Trail helps connect neighborhoods located in the area north of Interstate 70 and south of Indian Hills Park to the Columbia trail system. No unauthorized motorized vehicles are allowed on the trail. The trail experiences moderate daily recreational and commuter use with increased traffic on weekends.
