# **COST & MATERIALS**

Pre-approved park/trail locations\*......\$2,500 Customized park/trail locations......\$3,500 installation price includes labor, materials, maintenance and a 2" x 10" zinc plaque. Benches are made of environmentally-friendly recycled plastic lumber. Benches will be installed on a concrete pad at select locations.

# **INSTALLATION**

Exact placement requires staff approval. Benches will be installed at approved sites within four months after payment and approval of plaque design and text.

# MEMORIAL/HERITAGE TREE & BENCH PROGRAM

The Memorial/Heritage Tree and Bench Program allows groups and individuals to donate trees and/or benches to commemorate special events or as memorials to loved ones. Trees and benches purchased through the program are planted and placed in city parks, trails, golf courses and playgrounds. Exact placement is at the discretion of the Parks and Recreation Department.

# TREE PROGRAM

Through the Memorial/Heritage Program, the public can donate a tree or adopt an existing tree, to commemorate a life event or to be planted as a memorial to a loved one. Large shade trees such as oak, bald cypress and sycamore trees are available as well as ornamental species such as redbud, red maple or yellowwood trees.

### **COST & MATERIALS**

Tree, zinc plaque & ongoing maintenance.....\$500 Ongoing maintenance includes mulching, pruning, etc. Trees are living things and longevity cannot be guaranteed. Trees that succumb during the first 10 years will be replaced at no additional expense.

## PLANTING AND INSTALLATION

Trees ordered from March 16 to Sept. 15 will be planted in the late fall. Trees ordered from Sept. 16 to March 15 will be planted in the spring. Zinc plaques will be installed 6-8 weeks following planting.

# TREE SPECIES AND PARK SELECTION

Species selection may be dependent on the chosen location. Select parks/trails have reached maximum planting capacity. **Prior to submitting** the form and payment, please contact the Parks and Recreation Forester at 573.874.7520 for confirmation regarding tree species and location.
