Stephens Lake Park Perimeter Trail

Length 1.7 miles, loop trail

The Perimeter Trail meanders around the perimeter of the park facilitating in-line skaters, cyclists, walkers and joggers' enjoyment of the park's natural beauty. As users navigate the perimeter trail they pass by the riparian corridor along Hinkson Creek, open space as well as wooded areas, and even an art sculpture in the park. The trail serves as the E. Walnut St. sidewalk on the park's north side. No unauthorized motorized vehicles are allowed on the trail. The trail experiences exceptionally heavy daily recreational and commuter use with increased traffic on weekends
