**RE:** Resolution Approving the Transfer of Funds from the Convention & Visitors Bureau to the Parks & Recreation Department for the 2011 Heritage Festival

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:** The Council approved funding of the FY2011 Signature Series events in October 2010 with R233-10.

The Signature Series events are funded at \$10,000 per year with an additional \$2,000 per event, set aside for out-of-market promotion & advertising. The Heritage Festival is one of the approved events and requires a transfer of funds from the Convention & Visitors Bureau to the Parks & Recreation Department.

The following festivals & events are classified as Signature Series: Art in the Park, J.W. Blind Boone Ragtime & Jazz Festival, First Night, Heritage Festival, True/False Film Festival, UMC Concert Series Holiday Festival, and MS 150 Script Express Bike Ride.

**DISCUSSION:** During the process of funding approval for the FY2011 events, the Heritage Festival was approved for funding but the actual Transfer of Funds Request form did not get processed. All other contracts for the remaining six events were completed.

This request is simply to authorize the transfer of funds to Parks & Recreation. All funds have been appropriated in the 2011 budget.
