Re: USTA 10 & Under Painting Reimbursement & Antimi Sports Complex Appropriation

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Parks and Recreation Department is requesting Council action to appropriate funds in the total amount of \$5,506.06 from the Park Operations Miscellaneous Revenue Account and the Recreation Services Miscellaneous Revenue Account to the appropriate operating accounts for their intended use.

DISCUSSION:

The Parks and Recreation Department is requesting \$4,560.00 received as a grant reimbursement for 10 & under line painting on regulation tennis courts at Cosmo-Bethel Park and at Columbia Cosmopolitan Recreation Area be appropriated to the Park Operations Contract Services account. The line painting on the tennis courts has been completed and the Parks and Recreation Department has received the reimbursement check from the United States Tennis Association. The additional tennis court lines allow the Parks and Recreation Department as well as local user groups to host tennis tournaments specifically for youth under 10 years old that require a smaller court size. The additional lines do not interfere with any events or individual play that is hosted on the courts on an annual basis.

Parks and Recreation Staff is also requesting Council action to appropriate \$946.06 from the Recreation Services Miscellaneous Revenue account to the Antimi Sports Complex Capital Project account. The requested appropriation of funds is available due to the sale of twelve (12) 21-foot player benches that were replaced after the completion of the Rainbow Softball Complex renovations. The appropriated money will be used to make necessary fencing repairs and fund the addition of yellow protective fence crown to all six fields at the complex.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The USTA grant reimbursement of \$4,560.00 will reimburse the operating account for the corresponding expenditure for the painting of the additional tennis court lines. All expenditures are offset by the corresponding reimbursement. The \$946.06 in player bench revenue will be appropriated to the Antimi Sports Complex FY13 park project account to facilitate expenditure for fencing repairs and upgrades.
