We appreciate the support of the City of Columbia, and the working relationship that exists between the Parks and Recreation Department and the Society. We look forward to working with you during another successful year of serving the community.

In partnership with the City of Columbia Parks and Recreation Department, the Boone County Historical Society puts the appropriated funding to use in administering the Maplewood Farm Site and the Gordon Cabin located in Historic Nifong Park; and continues to use the services of a caretaker to supplement security in the park and upkeep of the sites.

Working closely with Parks and Recreation, and with support from Society volunteers, and private funding, the Society keeps the Maplewood House open for tours each Sunday, May through September; hosts events that celebrate the history of the house, including *Maplewood by Candlelight* in December, in partnership with the Maplewood Barn Theater Group; and makes the house available to other groups in the community for tours and gatherings. Funding goes toward cleaning and minor repair to interior furnishings; and for brochures, publicity and promotion of this historic house.

John Fetters continues to serve as property manager in Historic Nifong Park, providing supplemental park security, and serving as first responder for all alarm calls for both the Maplewood House, Gordon Cabin, and other accessory buildings in the park; and assists with traffic control and direction during all events held in the park.

For FY2013 we are formally requesting the funds which we understand have been appropriated in your current budget be released, including \$5,000 which goes toward the continued upkeep of Maplewood House; and \$14,000 toward the caretaker's salary.

Historical Museum Operating Agreement

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

This resolution will authorize the City Manager to sign an agreement with the Boone County Historical Society (BCHS). This agreement will authorize the City to pay BCHS \$5,000 for services rendered and administering the historic buildings at Nifong Park.

#### DISCUSSION:

In the Parks and Recreation Department's FY 2013 budget, the City Council approved spending \$5,000 for maintaining the museum hours and for administering the Maplewood Farm Historic Site located at Nifong Park. The City and the Boone County Historical Society have been in partnership since the City's acquisition of Nifong Park in 1970. This money is provided to BCHS for interpretive programs and improvements to the buildings and grounds associated with the Maplewood site. This is the same level of funding support as in Fiscal Year 2012.

Attached is a letter from BCHS outlining their operation and improvement plans, along with their funding request.
