
Please consider the following Citizens Police Review Board (CPRB) Supplement to our 2019 Annual Report. At the time this report was provided to City Council, the Columbia Police Department (CPD) had yet to finalize their annual reports. Below is a summary of complainant demographic details and complaint findings that compares changes from 2018 to 2019. For reference, the 2014, 2015, 2016, and 2017 numbers are included.

The Mayor and Council previously expressed an interest in having the CPRB prepare further analysis of the materials released by the CPD. As the CPD supplies demographic breakdown on only external complaints, those will be the focus of our analysis. Given the limitations of CPD's data, CPRB does not make conclusions based on these numbers. Instead, it aims to use this information as it undertakes its duties.



While the CPRB hesitates to generalize based on this material alone, we plan to take it into consideration as we continue our work, whether that be outreach, educational programming, complaint review, or other matters. As CPD's reporting becomes more robust, we expect to be able to provide more granular analysis to the Council in the future.

Additionally, CPRB recognizes the new CPD annual analysis pertaining to Response to Resistance, Pursuit of Motor Vehicle, and Bias Policing CPD, but at this time has no responses to these reports.
