The Geological Survey Program (GSP) has completed the technical review of the "Detailed Site Investigation Work Plan for the City of Columbia Landfill Proposed Expansion" dated April 22, 2019, and prepared by Weaver Consultants Group. The proposed expansion is approximately one hundred forty four (144) acres immediately south of the existing landfill, with a sub-base grade elevation of 740 feet amsl, to be used primarily for sanitary waste.

The work plan details the site-specific requirements to characterize the geologic and hydrologic conditions of the proposed expansion as defined in 10 CSR 80-2.015, Appendix I, for conducting a detailed site investigation. Therefore, GSP approves the work plan, and the proposed disposal area may now advance to the detailed site investigation (DSI) phase to further evaluate whether it is geologically and hydrologically suitable as a solid waste disposal area.
