Position Title: Instructors/Leaders for a Youth Jump Rope & Double Dutch Group

Requirements: People that are consistent, and good with children. Must be at least 20 years of age, active and willing to demonstrate. Dedicated individual that wants to make this program a success. Someone that can already jump rope & double dutch is preferred, but not a requirement.

Task: Come into practices with a plan, facilitate, choreograph routines, keep attendance, provide instruction, and find performance opportunities. This person would also be responsible for the promotion of the program to encourage growth.

Dates: 1-2 days per week. Instructors/Leaders will have flexibility on the scheduling of the program, but will need to ensure it fits with participant availability.
